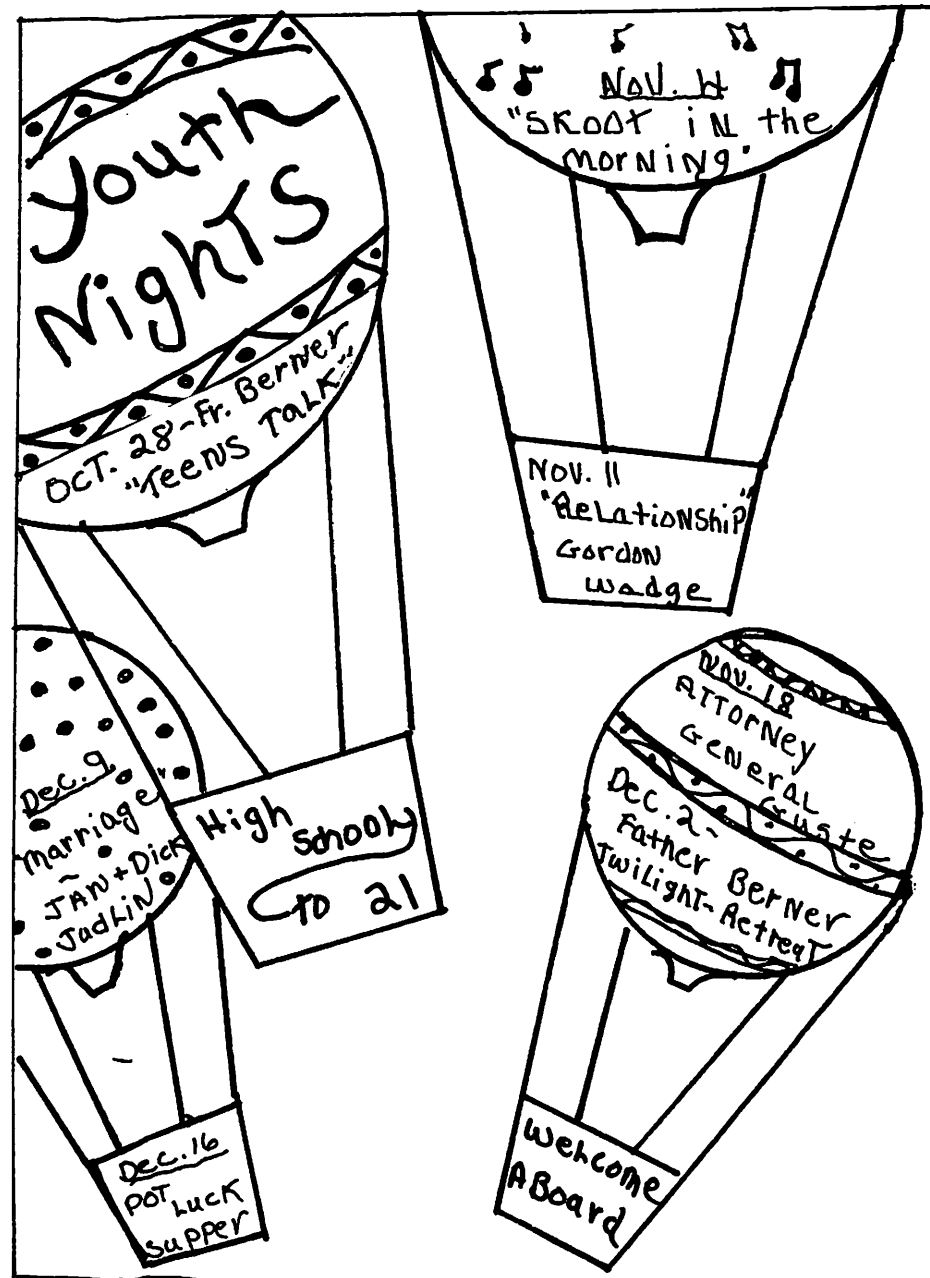





LITURGICAL READINGS. How times change. Today we might call the foolish virgins wise for not burning oil all night. (Gospel - Matthew 25/1-13). They were just conserving energy. 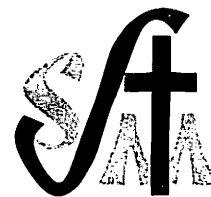

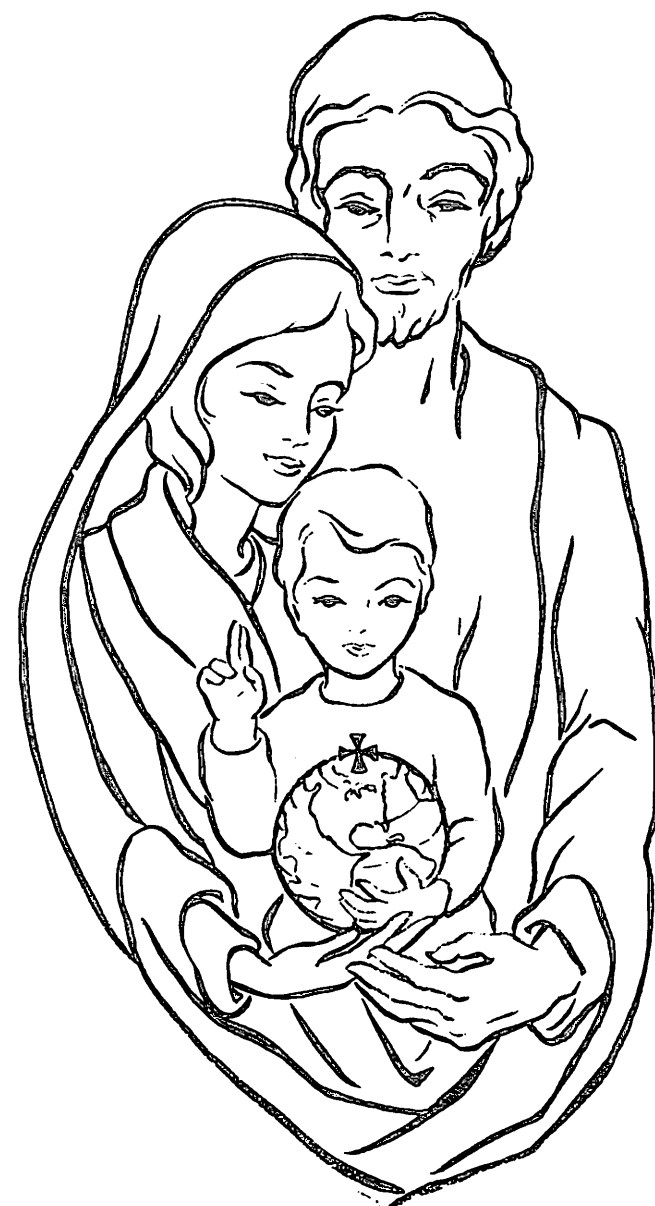
