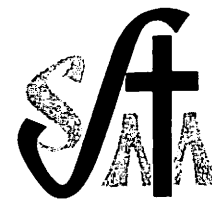

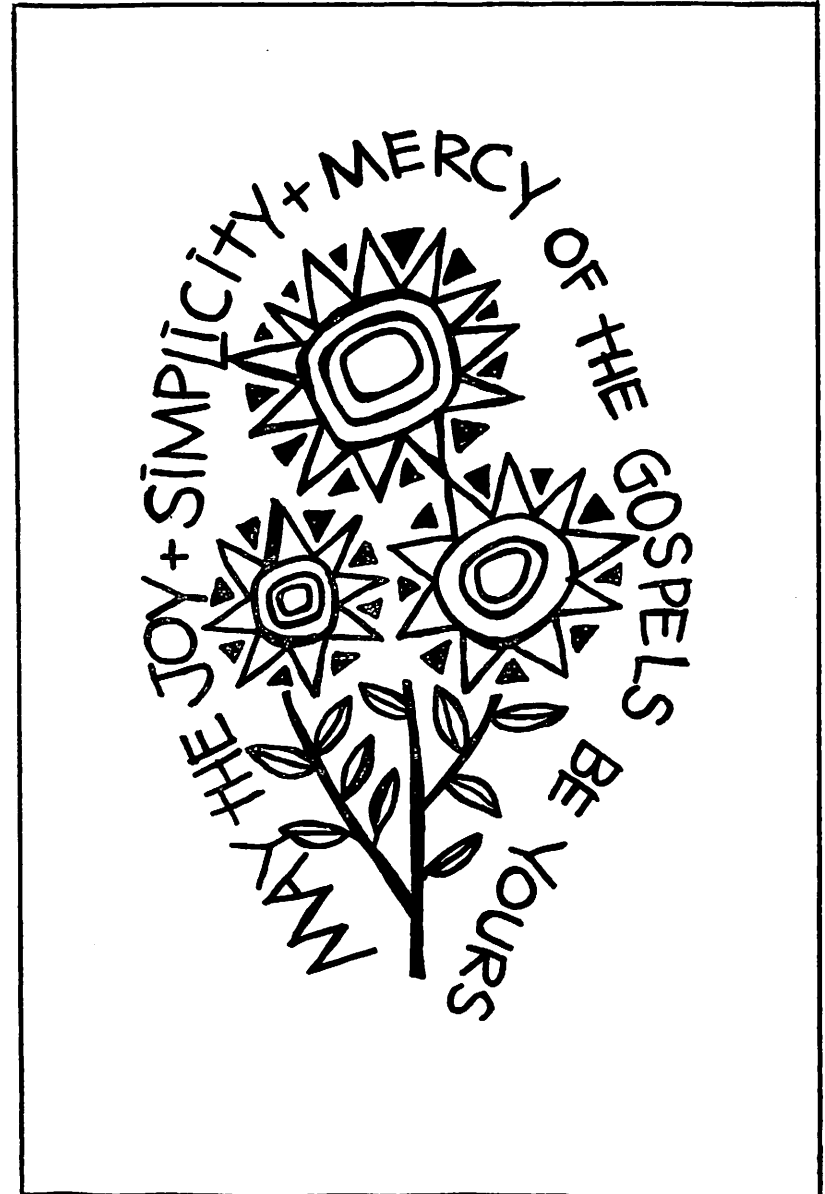

BAPTISM OF THE LORD

JESUS humbled Himself and received the baptism of John. This became the sign of His ministry, His service as "Beloved Son". Isaiah described Him prophetically. In our baptism, we, too were accepted by the Father and dedicated to the Christian life, which implies ministry, service. 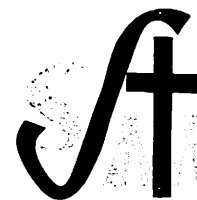

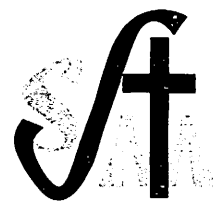

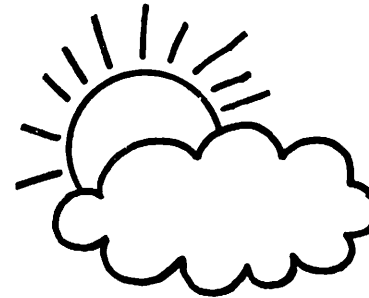

SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

LITURGICAL READINGS: In this Sunday's liturgy, Jesus did not come to preach merely a "spiritual" Gospel. He took care of people's basic needs, especially for physical healing. He did this because he was concerned about their bodies. And it was a sign that he loved their whole person.

SPECIAL NOTE: The School Board and Father Kern are pleased to announce that in order to provide continuing leadership and continuity in transition, we have contracted Mr. Tom Bernos to continue as principal through 1982-83 school year. EVERYTHING YOU ALWAYS WANTED TO KNOW ABOUT DEACONS, BUT WERE AFRAID TO ASK. . . There seem to be many questions concerning the Deacons in the Parish, and elsewhere. Here are some answers to the most asked questions. ARE DEACONS ORDAINED? Yes, in a ceremony very similar to Priests. CAN DEACONS OFFICIATE AT RELIGIOUS FUNCTIONS? Yes, at Weddings, Baptisms, funeral services and assisting at Mass. DO DEACONS GET PAID FOR THEIR DIACONAL WORK? No, Deacons are not paid for the services mentioned above, but if they work for the parish in other capacities, they may draw salaries. None of the Deacons keep any money received from the religious functions they may preside over. MAY DEACONS MARRY? No, unless they are married when they are ordained, they may not marry. If single, they take the vow of celibacy; if married when ordained, they take the vow of conditional celibacy. For more information, ask a Deacon.

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are the only days of fast and abstinence during Lent. All Fridays in Lent are days of abstinence. We would also hope that we have some additional forms of private penance.

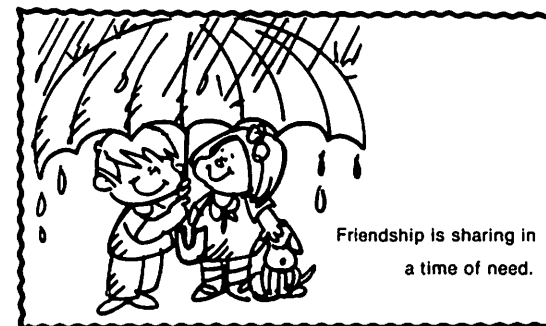

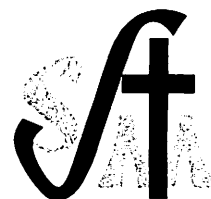

SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT

LITURGICAL READINGS. The theme for this Sunday's liturgy is the experience of religious awe. Events in the lives of Jesus and his apostles, and of Abraham in the Old Testament, give expression to a human response basic to our Christian religion. In the first reading (Genesis 22/1-2, 9-13, 15-18) Abraham comes to see that the killing of his son Isaac is inconsistent with the true worship of the God of love. In the Gospel (Mark 9/2-10) though Jesus is the suffering servant who is to undergo an agonizing death, he is God's own Son as well. 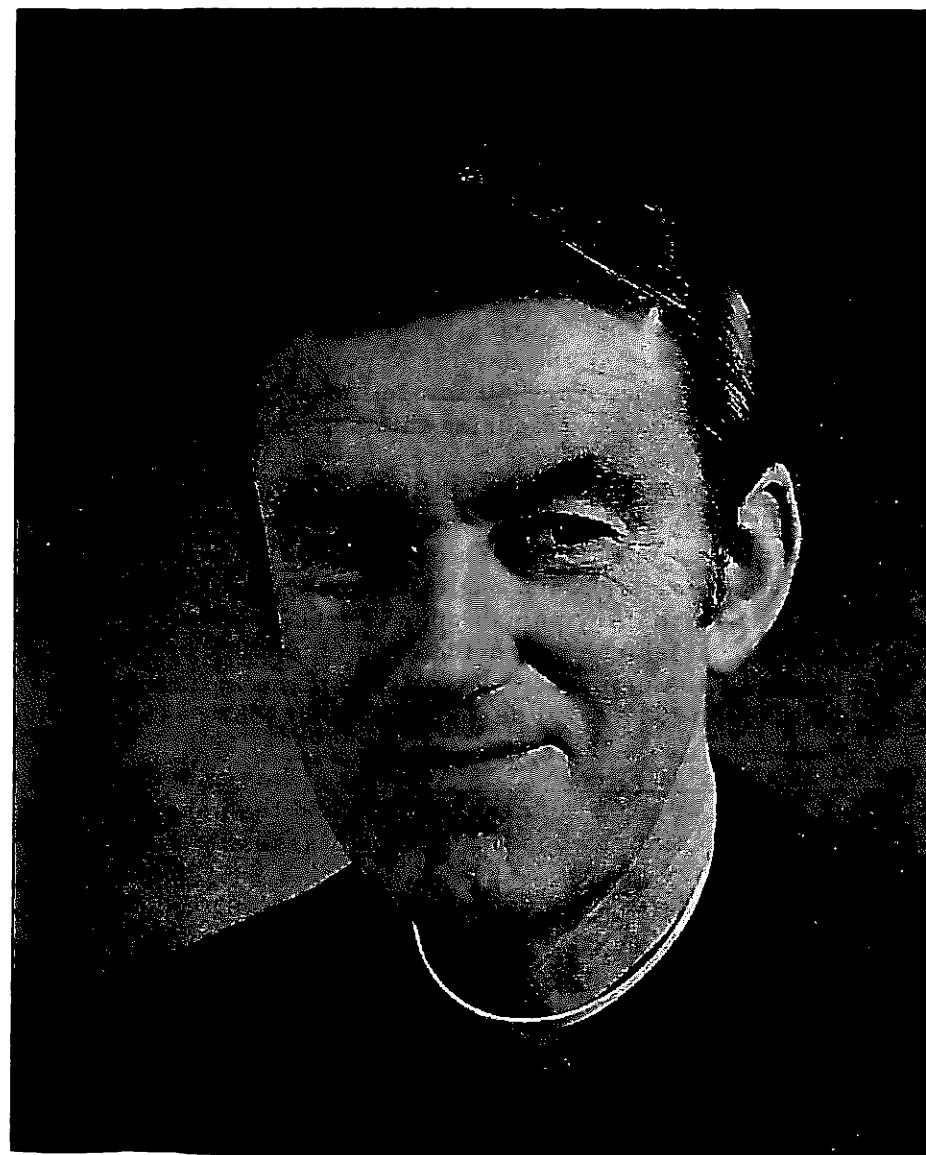

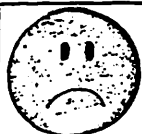
THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT

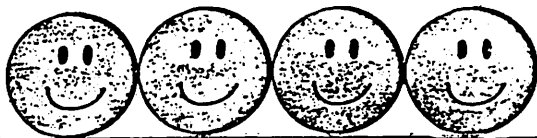

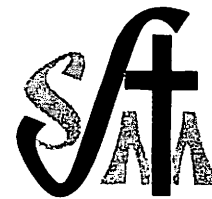
