





There is one crucial thing your children need from you for the rest of their lives: They need to feel entirely at home with God; they need to find out how to pray.

Prayer is caught rather than taught. Children need to see their parents praying. They need to pray together with their parents.

In the first years of their lives, children simply watch and imitate what dad and mom do. They fold their hands, they kneel down, they learn a sense of reverence.

As they grow into childhood, they learn to ask for things. They seek protection when they are afraid of a storm and thunder. They begin to petition the Lord for all the things they want to have.

As persons mature into the teen years, usually God is no longer seen as simply the provider for their needs, someone to whom they go to ask for handouts. They begin to experience a sense of deep and personal relationship to God.

But this process of growth in prayer will occur only in a family in which the parents themselves pray. Dad and mom must be the models of prayer. Sadly, there are many, many children who cannot recall ever seeing their parents praying at home. How can parents get across to their children the value of prayer if it is absent from their own lives? Prayer must be caught.

On the other hand, how blessed are those whose parents utter spontaneous prayers of gratitude, of praise, of petition on many occasions every week. They experience quiet moments when dad or mom stop by church for a quick visit on the way home from shopping.

Mealtimes are the most natural prayer times for a bustling, busy family. Many families offer spontaneous grace before meals. The parents begin the practice and encourage children to join in as soon as they are able and are interested.

Other families make use of the responsorial psalm from the previous Sunday's liturgy. Family members take turns being the leader and the others respond, just as we do at Mass.

Practice your faith and trust and love openly. Bring God into your family's life every day. This is one of the most important gifts that you, as a parent, can pass on to your children.

To help us prepare a meaningful Family Cay celebration, we ask your help in the following ways:


- Print your family's name and the special gift your family is to our parish family on the symbol on the reverse side of this page.
