### The "Look-And-See" Rosarv

The man and the woman, strangers to each other, were sitting side by side on the plane flight. The man noticed his seat companion was fingering a brown rosary.

"I'm a Catholic too," he said. "Name is James Richard."

"I'm Mrs. Connors. Glad to meet you here. I was just beginning my Rosary."

"You always say it while travel-

ling?" Mr. Richard asked.
"Well, I don't travel that much anymore since I turned seventy-three. But I must say I've fallen in love again with the Rosary devotion, after I had set it aside for a while, back in those years just after Vatican II."

That's about the time I stopped saying mine. Don't you find it monoto-

nous, though?"

"I used to, but a friend helped me put new life into my prayer. She taught me the 'look-and-see' approach which I've been using ever since."

Mr. Richard looked immediately interested. "Tell me about it. Might

revive my interest."

"Well, this friend taught me the method she'd been using. You look up to God, look within yourself, look around to relatives and friends, look back to God's great wonders in the past, then forward to see the marvels that await us in the future."

"So you call it the 'look-and-see' method. I can see why." Mr. Richard smiled. "Excuse me for interrupting. Do go on."

"In the Rosary prayers, we look up

to God, as we say the Creed, the Glory Be's and the Our Father's. We think how great and good and powerful He is - the Father almighty who wants

us to ask Him for our daily bread."
"I see," said Mr. Richard. "And then you look within yourself?"

Exactly. As I meditate on the Rosary mysteries which bring back to mind certain episodes in the lives of Jesus and Our Blessed Mother, I

think about the virtues they practiced. Then I ask myself how am I measuring up, how have I learned from them. They showed us love, obedience, humility, patience, faith, detachment, and many other Christian virtues.'

"Then you look around at your friends?" Mr. Richard was recalling the summation his seat companion

had given him.

"They all have needs - some I know about, some unknown to me but very well known to God. Just as I ask Our Lady to intercede for me, so I intercede for my relatives and friends. We have extraordinary ministers of the Eucharist, so why shouldn't we have extraordinary ministers of intercession?"

"Never thought of that, Mrs.

Connors.

"It's on my mind all the time. My Rosary meditations bring back to mind the mighty things God did, like sending His Son to live and die for us, then raising Him from the dead and sharing the bliss of heaven with Him — and then raising Mary in body and soul to heaven."

"And the future?" Mr. Richard

asked.

"The miracles God will still do. The powerful promises of the Bible becoming a reality — His help in our sorrows, His bringing us to heaven later. And then the resurrection to look forward to -"

"That 'look-and-see' angle again," said Mr. Richard. "Well, this surely makes the Rosary devotion sound a lot more interesting. Think I'll get

myself a new rosary.

Mrs. Connors opened her purse and brought out a black beaded rosary. "I always carry a spare," she said, smiling broadly. "Just in case I meet the right person to give it to." And she handed the black-beaded rosary to Mr. Richard, who accepted it with gratitude.




