SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT

In the second reading (Philippians 3:17-4:1) St. Paul tells us not to be deceived into thinking we are Christians. The transformation into the image of Christ must be apparent and not vague. For this we need others to imitate and to tell us whether we are being faithful to the covenant of change that Jesus' life and death proclaims. Jesus warns us to recognize the need for reform, for growth, for change within ourselves.


Jesus reminds us that God, who calls us to a change of heart, is a patient, forgiving God.
