

SIXTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

LITURGICAL READINGS: One unifying thought in the readings for this Sunday's liturgy is the presence of the Lord. Abraham senses something special in the presence of the three visitors (Gn 18/1-10). Paul proclaims the mystery of the presence of Christ in us (Col. 1/24-28). Mary and Martha respond differ- ently to the presence of Jesus in their home (Lk 10/38-42). As the believing Christian community we are aware of the presence of the Lord in our lives. This is our hope, the mystery that has been revealed to us, the mystery that we preach to others. When we gather at the Eucharist, we proclaim the presence of the Lord in the assembly, in His Holy Word, in the sacrament of His Body and Elood. We live in the presence of the Lord.

MISSIONARY APPEAL. Plans are being made to start new missions in an area where the people - all Hindus and Muslims are very enthusiastic. In this arid, poor, faminine-stricken area attempts are made to help the poor to develop themselves. Your generous response to this appeal is sought to assist in these needs.

LITURGICAL READINGS. God aims a question at us in the 1st reading (Wis. 9/13-18): Without prayer, how can our limited human nature finally find the right thing to do? How can we discover the right way to go? In the 2nd reading (Phil. 1/9-10, 12-17) we have the heart of Paul's short letter to Philemon. He appeals to this wealthy Christian of Colossae to take back Onesimus, an escaped slave, who had been converted by Paul to Christianity. And he asks for his acceptance as a brother in Christ, no longer as a slave. Jesus' parables in the Gospel (Luke 14/25-33) are intended to make us think: Are we prepared to be as practical in our decision to follow him as a king would be in deciding what the prudent course is to take? Jesus says our practical course is putting God absolutely first.


