

### THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

THE FEAST OF ST. ANGELA MERICI is observed on January 27, on the church calendar. St. Angela founded the Ursuline Community and named the order after the patroness of Catholic education, St. Ursula. The Ursuline Sisters arrived in New Orleans in 1727. Over 200 years later, in September of 1965, they began their teaching apostolate in the parish named for their foundress, St. Angela Merici. Our parish will celebrate the feast of St. Angela next Sunday, Jan. 29th.

STEWARDSHIP AND PARISH ENVELOPES. One of the most direct forms of Stewardship is the simple act of making a weekly gift of money back to God, through our parish offertory collection. After all, when we give of our income we are giving a part of our material selves. And the best way to make that gift is by use of our parish envelopes. Using the envelopes helps you properly plan ahead. As you budget your monthly or weekly expenses you can properly make your Church contribution FIRST and, thus, insure that Christ is coming FIRST in your lives. Envelopes serve as a good source of record-keeping, particularly at the year's end when you are preparing your income tax deductions. If you're not already using the envelopes, ask for a set.

THE 1983 YEAR END CONTRIBUTION STATEMENTS have been mailed to parishioners who have been using the envelopes. The statement does not include contribution for any special collections. If you have not received your form or question the amount shown, please contact the rectory.





FASTING & ABSTINENCE REGULATIONS FOR LENT:

Fasting - eat only one full meal a day (applies to ages 21 until 59 years of age)

Abstinence - abstain from meat (applies to ages 14 and over)
Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are the only days of fast and
abstinence during Lent. All Fridays in Lent are days of abstinence. We would also hope that we have some additional
forms of private penance.


