





ADVENT

We all know how the true meaning of the Christmas is annually overshadowed by our urges to give, to buy, to sell and to get. Why do we fail to hear the word of God at Christmas? Partly because we usually listen only to the narratives of Christ's birth and nothing else. The coming of Christ is more than that. At a moment in the public life of our Lord, when the Apostles showed signs of becoming over-confident in their abilities. Christ told them, "Without me you can do nothing". That admonition applies to us also. Advent is a time for us to become more vitally aware of that fact. He expects us to strive to give good example and positive leadership in moral concerns. Our personal lives should reflect the discipline, charity, sacrifice and justice that He demands of His followers. Our personal faith must radiate a spirit of confidence in God's continuing providence. Christ came to make the world a better place. The first step toward bettering the world in which we live starts within the souls of you and me. Advent is a time to start that trend.

SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT

IMMACULATE CONCEPTION, Saturday, December 8th, is a holyday of obligation. A Vigil Mass will be celebrated on Friday, December 7th, at 4:00pm. On Saturday morning Masses will be at 6:15am, 9:00am and 12 noon. On Saturday afternoon we will have the usual Vigil Masses for the Sunday celebrated at 4:00 and 5:30pm and these Masses could be attended to fulfill your obligation for the Immaculate Conception obligation but, obviously, one Mass does not fulfill the double obligation. You must attend one Mass for the Feast of the Immaculate Conception and one for the Sunday obligation.

SPECIAL COLLECTION this weekend. At all the Masses on Saturday afternoon and on Sunday, we will have a special second collection to aid the drought-stricken countries in Africa. In Ethopia alone, an estimated six to ten million people are facing starvation - 2.5 million of them in immediate life-threatening jeopardy. Half are children. Public news reports we have received are in no way exaggerated. Please be generous in your response. "As often as you did it for one of my least ones's you did it for me" (Mt 25:40) graphically teaches us of Christ's presence in our neighbors in need and our need to respond.


