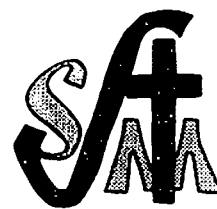

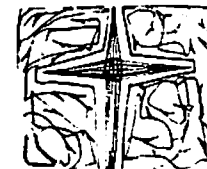

### FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT

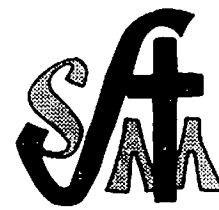

### SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT

**LITURGICAL READINGS.** The theme for this Sunday's liturgy is the experience of religious awe. Events in the lives of Jesus and his apostles, and of Abraham in the Old Testament, give expression to a human response basic to our Christian religion. In the first reading (Gen 22/1-2, 9-13, 15-18), Abraham comes to see that the killing of his son, Isaac, is inconsistent with the true worship of the God of love. 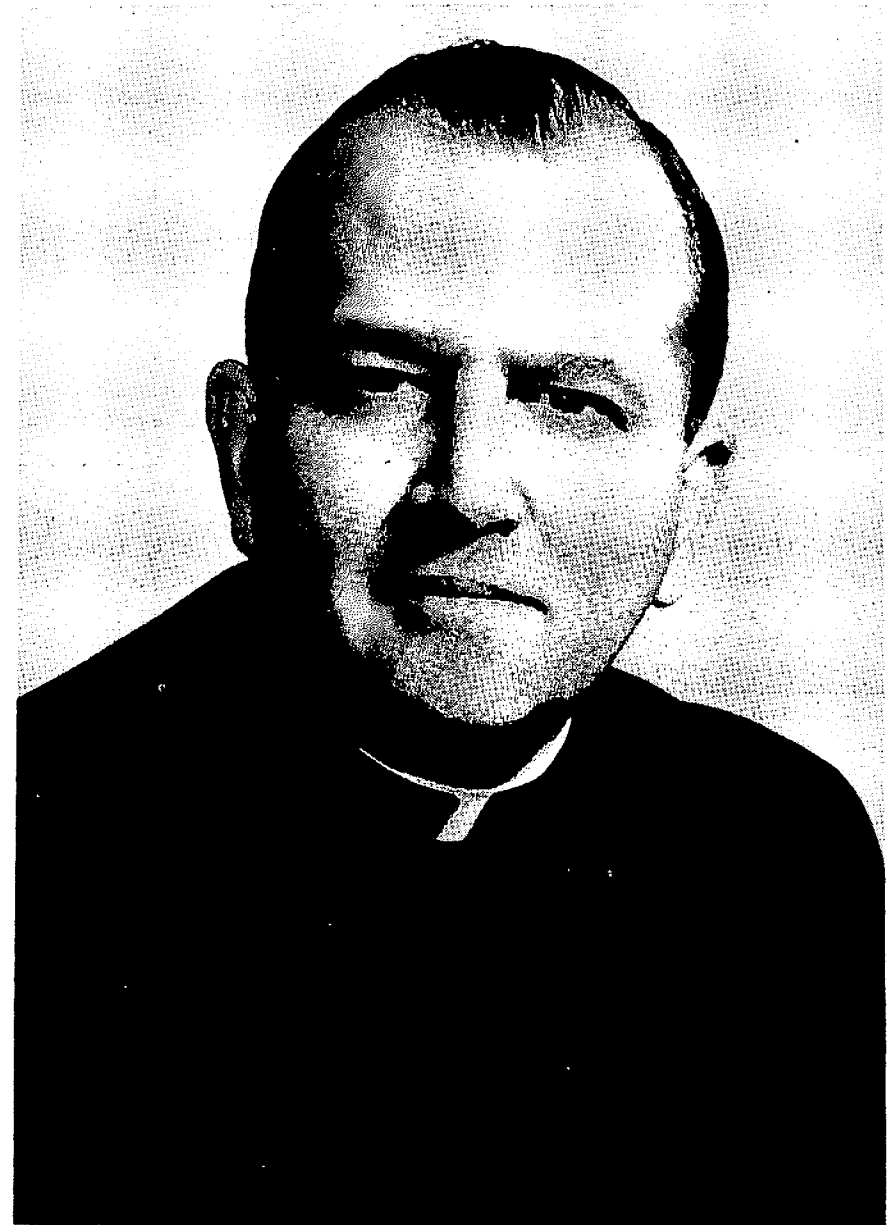

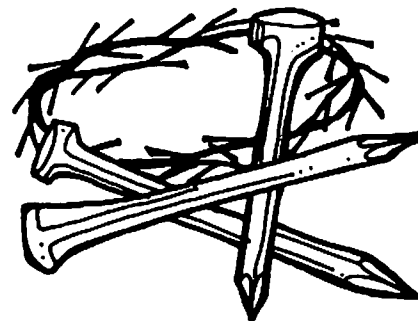
