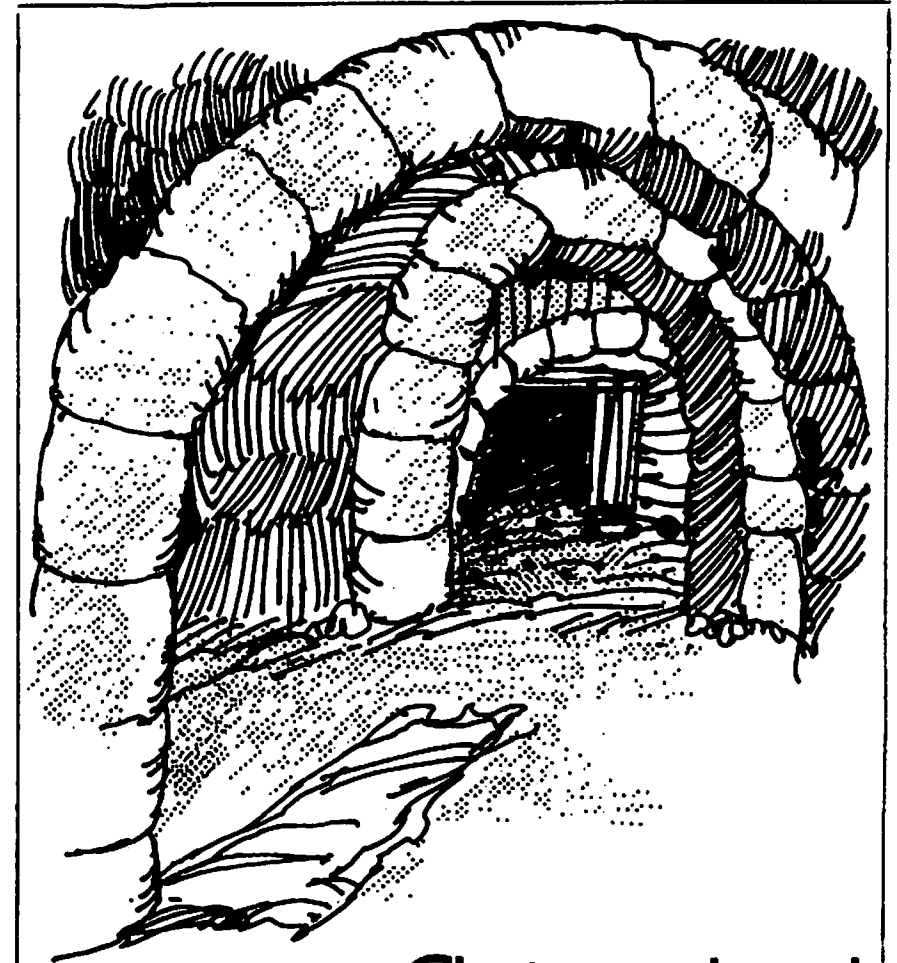

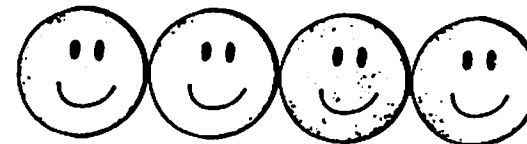

SECOND SUNDAY OF EASTER

ONE HEART AND MIND. The spirit of Easter breathed through the early Christian community, "of one heart and one mind". For they had "come through water and blood" and were to "conquer the world". Jesus brought them peace and forgiveness. During Eastertide we recall our baptism - death and resurrection in Christ - and the other Easter sacrament, that of reconciliation and peace. Penance is a sort of renewal of baptism and is meant to give peace, not anxiety or fear. In the Eucharist we share in the same risen Christ. Sharing at the same table our wealth with others, in the spirit of the first Christians.

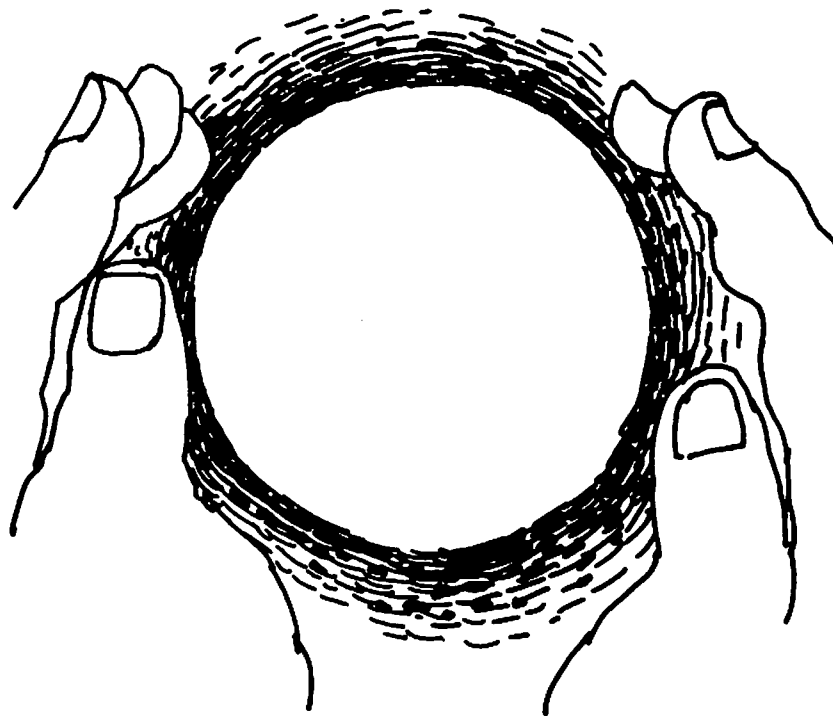
