

Some people re-enact the Epiphany with their Christmas creche characters. Set far across the room from the stable scene, the figures of the three kings begin their journey during Advent. Little by little, they are moved closer to the manger until they finally join Mary, Joseph, and Jesus.

At the same time that the family's three king statues are being assisted in their journey, relatives, neighbors, and friends who seek the Lord are sometimes left to flounder alone. It becomes abundantly clear that while we easily rejoice in the historical event of Jesus being made manifest in all people, living the meaning of what we celebrate comes far less easily.

There is no star of Bethlehem in the night skies to guide the journey of those who wish to find Jesus. If Jesus is to be made manifest to all people, it is up to his followers to make his presence known.

MEMBERS OF THE SAME BODY

Paul speaks clearly of the meaning of the Epiphany in today's second reading: "In Christ Jesus, the Gentiles are now co-heirs with the lews,

members of the same body and sharers of the promise." Our God is an inclusive God, a God who welcomes all people, who loves all people.

The measure of our faithfulness to the message of the Epiphany is not determined by whether we have moved the three kings closer to the creche. Our faithfulness is measured by whether we have grown closer to the Lord, and whether other people, through us, have found him.

It is easy to move three statues of ancient foreigners toward a manger scene. It is a real challenge to reach out to those who are "foreign" to us today because they are of some other race or denomination or culture.

The Epiphany question is not what statues are in our creche, but what people do we welcome into our lives. For there is but one Messiah and he came for all of us.





JANUARY 13, 1991 • Baptism of the Lord

Those who are gifted with musical ability and who are called to use that ability in ministry can have a profound influence on the faith community. Vocalists and musicians who have the talent to ply their crafts in the secular sphere, and sometimes do, find a special dimension in their ministry which is different from other musical experiences. Music ministry is not about prima donnas and performances, but about invitation and affirmation and a harmony deeper than the blending of voices.

I have witnessed the magnificence of choirs which have enhanced the eucharistic celebration, and I have marvelled at the way an assembly can be united by a well-rendered familiar hymn.

I have been moved by expert renditions of ancient chants and enthused by the energy and art employed by a music director "warming up" a congregation and teaching us to sing a new song to the Lord.

PRAISING GOD

Perhaps the most memorable embodiment of the meaning of music ministry came at a simple Sunday liturgy. The cantor prayerfully led us in song, her crys-

tal clear tones leading the way in perfect time with the organ. In the third pew there was a man who consistently sang a full line ahead of anyone else, and in decibels louder than the rest of the assembly combined.

At liturgy's end, the cantor descended the steps and, with great grace, addressed the third-pew songster: "You sing with such gusto!" she said, smiling and touching the man's arm gently. "You must love God a lot!"

God bless such music ministers, who call forth our best efforts to praise the Lord, and who praise our efforts, though our performance sometimes falls short.



JANUARY 20, 1991 2nd Sunday in Ordinary Time

In today's first reading, Samuel hears the Lord's voice, but mistakes it for Eli's. Fortunately, Eli was familiar with the Lord's way and could help Samuel to respond to the Lord.

As we seek the Lord, it is good to have someone like Eli who is familiar with the Lord's voice and his ways. There are many voices which bid us "follow this way" and the Lord's call is not always easy to discern. There are people, too,

who would pretend to know the Lord and draw others to themselves rather than to God.

Eli could have taken advantage of Samuel's naivete and claimed it was he who had summoned Samuel. Eli could have told Samuel: "I was the Lord who is calling and I will tell you what the Lord asks." But Eli neither claims to be God nor to speak for God. Instead, he has Samuel to listen for himself.

WHAT ARE YOU LOOKING FOR?

Perhaps the most simple yet most profound line in all of today's readings is Jesus' question to the two disciples who begin to follow him. "What are you looking for?" he asks plainly and directly.

Finding the Messiah was partly a matter of what one was looking for. If one lived with the expectation of the Messiah's coming, there was no doubt, a certain alertness, a watchfulness to life. The two disciples had followed John the Baptizer, but as soon as John pointed to Jesus, they were ready to follow him.

It has been said that what we find in life is pretty much what we have sought. "What are you looking for?" is a challenging question for us to ask of ourselves. Our honest answer to that question can reveal much about our faith and our values.

Those who, like Andrew and the other disciple, are looking for the Messiah will find him. He dwells now, as he did then, among his people. "Come and see!"



IANUARY 27, 1991 3rd Sunday in Ordinary Time

All of today's readings reflect some urgency, some lack of time. Jonah warns the Ninevites: "Forty days more and Nineveh shall be destroyed." Paul reminds the Corinthians that "the time is short"..."the world as we know it is passing away." Jesus

proclaims that "this is the time of fulfillment." There is no denying that we humans tend to respond more readily to an urgent request and seem to be forever motivated by those things which must be done now. A common excuse for putting something off is: "Oh, we've got time for that later."

For the people in Jonah's day, for the people of Jesus' time and Paul's time, the end was believed to be immanent. The words of the prophets and reformers frequently included a sense of urgency.

We don't know, of course, how much time we have as individuals or as nations to reform our ways, but there's less time left today than yesterday.

BELIEVE IN THE GOOD NEWS

Jesus' urgent message to the people of Galilee contained two declarative statements and two important ones. A command to "reform your lives" is frequently issued by parents and judges and teachers. It is far less common to hear a command which requires faith. Yet Jesus says: "believe in the good news." He does not say: "I hope you can believe" or "could you consider believing?"

Believing in the good news is not unreasonable, but it does call for some leaps of faith now and then.

If we try believing in the good news, and acting accordingly, we may just make a difference in the world. But, it seems we'd better hurry!

Today's Readings: Jon. 3:1-5, 10; 1 Cor. 7:29-31; Mk. 1:14-20.





Since unclean spirits and evil are so adept at disguising themselves, people are always in need of prophets who can point them out.

Prophets remind us of our covenant with God and they mercilessly strip unclean spirits of their illusory goodness. Prophets name the evils which lurk behind our rationalizations; they make it impossible for us to allow our selfishness, our greed, our desire for revenge to masquerade as good.

No wonder prophets were never very popular. They are even less popular today. Society has become a willing accomplice in our individual efforts to protect our unclean spirits. The "everybody's doing it" disguise encourages us to perceive unclean spirits as harmless; today's prophets remind us that good is not determined by majority rule.

Jesus proved his authority and power over unclean spirits; the prophets who speak to us in Jesus' name challenge us to confront the evils in our lives.

DEVOTE YOURSELVES TO THE LORD

While Paul's position on remaining single might appear to be logical, our experience tells another story. Whether we are single or married, there is an entice-

ment to be "busy with the world's demands." There are many married persons as well as single ones who are "busy with the Lord's affairs."

The unclean spirit which Paul is warning us about is common in any state of life; selfishness and a desire to conform to the world rather than be faithful to our primary vocation as Christians can be constant temptations.

"I should like you to be free of all worries," Paul writes to the community in Corinth. What a wonderful wish! With the economy, the threat of nuclear war, job insecurity, and illness, worry is a constant companion. Yet, the liturgy echoes Paul's wish as we pray to be free of all undue anxiety. Is worry an unclean spirit? Perhaps what Paul points to is our concern about the wrong things. If we "devote ourselves entirely to the Lord," we can turn our worries over to him.

What image comes to mind when you hear the term religious educator? The vocation of catechist is not image-specific. The call is issued and responded to by an amazing variety of people: male or female, young or old who can be dressed in anything from suits to cutoff jeans.

To be a religious educator is to be a minister of the Word: the Word proclaimed, the Word explained, the Word integrated with life, the Word modelled.

Religious educators ply their trade in many areas: in adult formation programs, in religious education classes, in Catholic schools, in youth ministries, in RCIA groups. These catechists receive some, though not nearly enough, recognition and support for their ministry. Less acclaimed are the primary religious educators—parents. Quietly and effectively many of them teach and model their children's faith in every loving act, in moments of forgiveness and reconciliation, in making decisions based on gospel values, in the multitude of mundane holy tasks.

The catechetical mission of the Church, crucial to its identity and future, flourishes through the vocation of religious educators.

I met a woman who has been a volunteer catechist in her parish for twenty years. "Your dedication is incredible!" I exclaimed, knowing her ministry is demanding as well as rewarding.

"It's nothing to brag about," she replied, "I only want to live my faith and to share it with others."

She echoed Paul's words in today's second reading: "Preaching the gospel is not the subject of a boast" for religious educators. But perhaps we who witness the importance and effectiveness of their vocation might boast about them and their indispensable ministry.

LENTEN FAST AND ABSTINENCE

The Law of Abstinence forbids the eating of meat and should be observed on Ash Wednesday and the Fridays of Lent. All those who are 14 years old are bound to the law of abstinence.

The Law of Fast prescribes that only one full meal a day be taken. Two smaller meals may be taken but together they should not equal another full meal. This law of fast should be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. The law of fast binds all who are 21 years old and not yet 59 years old.

Failure to observe individual days of penance is not considered serious; rather it is the failure to observe any penitential days at all or a substantial number of such days which must be considered serious. People should seek to do more rather than less to the Lord's call to penance and conversion of life.

MARDI GRAS AND ASH WEDNESDAY

Mardi Gras occurs the day before Ash Wednesday. It transforms our studious mood into that of festive merrymaking immediately before Lent. . The burning of palm branches for Ash Wednesday may symbolize the destruction of our bad habits as we begin Lent with firm resolves.

FEBRUARY 17, 1991 1st Sunday of Lent

In today's second reading Peter draws a parallel between the flood waters in Genesis, and the waters of baptism. In both waters there is something lost, something preserved, something new begun.

In Noah's story, the flood waters destroyed evil, preserved the good people, and marked the beginning of a new era.

In the waters of baptism, we pledge to die to selfishness, to preserve the real meaning of our human existence, to begin a new life in a community of believers.


In the flood story from Genesis, the water's effect was swift and lasting; the waters of baptism take effect gradually as we struggle to live up to our promises. Forty days and forty nights are hardly sufficient for us to achieve Christian perfection; forty days and forty nights each year, however, can enable us to make significant progress. "God patiently waited until the ark was built." We can count on God's patience with us too.

REFORM YOUR LIVES

We know little of Jesus' experience in the desert. He spent forty days there and we know he faced temptation, he was ministered to by angels, he fasted, and he prayed. We don't know many of the details of those forty days. What did Jesus pray? What insights and strength came to him? Besides the presumptions we can make about his physical feelings: hunger, thirst, discomfort from the heat—what did he feel emotionally, spiritually?

What we do know is that his desert experience changed Jesus profoundly. He clung to God's mission for him in spite of Satan's tests, and he emerged from his isolation on fire for the reign of God.

Jesus began his public ministry immediately after his days in the desert. And he preached, not tentatively, but with incredible certainty,



authority, and love as he spread God's Word.

What shall happen to us during our desert Lenten time? Perhaps the details are unimportant. The measure of the effectiveness of our Lent will be the degree to which we emerge from it more committed to the reign of God and more eager to making it real in this life.





FEBRUARY 24, 1991 2nd Sunday of Lent

It is interesting to note that, as they came down the mountain after Jesus' Transfiguration, Peter, James, and John "continued to discuss what 'to rise from the dead' meant." Why weren't they talking about what had just happened? Why weren't they sharing their reactions to seeing a transformed Jesus? Why weren't they commenting on the presence of Moses and Elijah? They had just witnessed an extraordinary scene and now they continued what was apparently an old discussion. Or was it? Perhaps the discussion of "rising from the dead" took on new meaning as they witnessed the long-dead Moses and Elijah. Perhaps seeing Jesus glorified, they began to understand "rising" in a new way. Perhaps the discussion of rising from the dead helped them to etch in their memories the meaning of the glory they had seen and to recall it as they faced Jesus' death—and their own!

"READY!"

Our ancestor in faith Abraham had a wealth of memories of his relationship with his faithful but surprising God. There was God's call to him, an invitation to leave his native land; there was God's promise that the childless Abraham's descendants would be as numerous as the stars; there was Sarah's miraculous pregnancy and the birth of their son, whom they would name Isaac, which means "laughter."

The memories which Abraham held of his relationship with God were rich and revealing. God initiated their story, but Abraham's faith was the necessary condition of its continuance. And if we read the story of God and Abraham, we see that each time God made a request, Abraham's response came more quickly and more surely.

In today's first reading we hear the remarkable response of a man of faith. "Abraham!" God calls. "Ready!" Abraham responds.

Lent invites us to remember our stories with God so that we might strengthen our faith and quicken our response to God's new call in our lives.
