HOLY WEEK

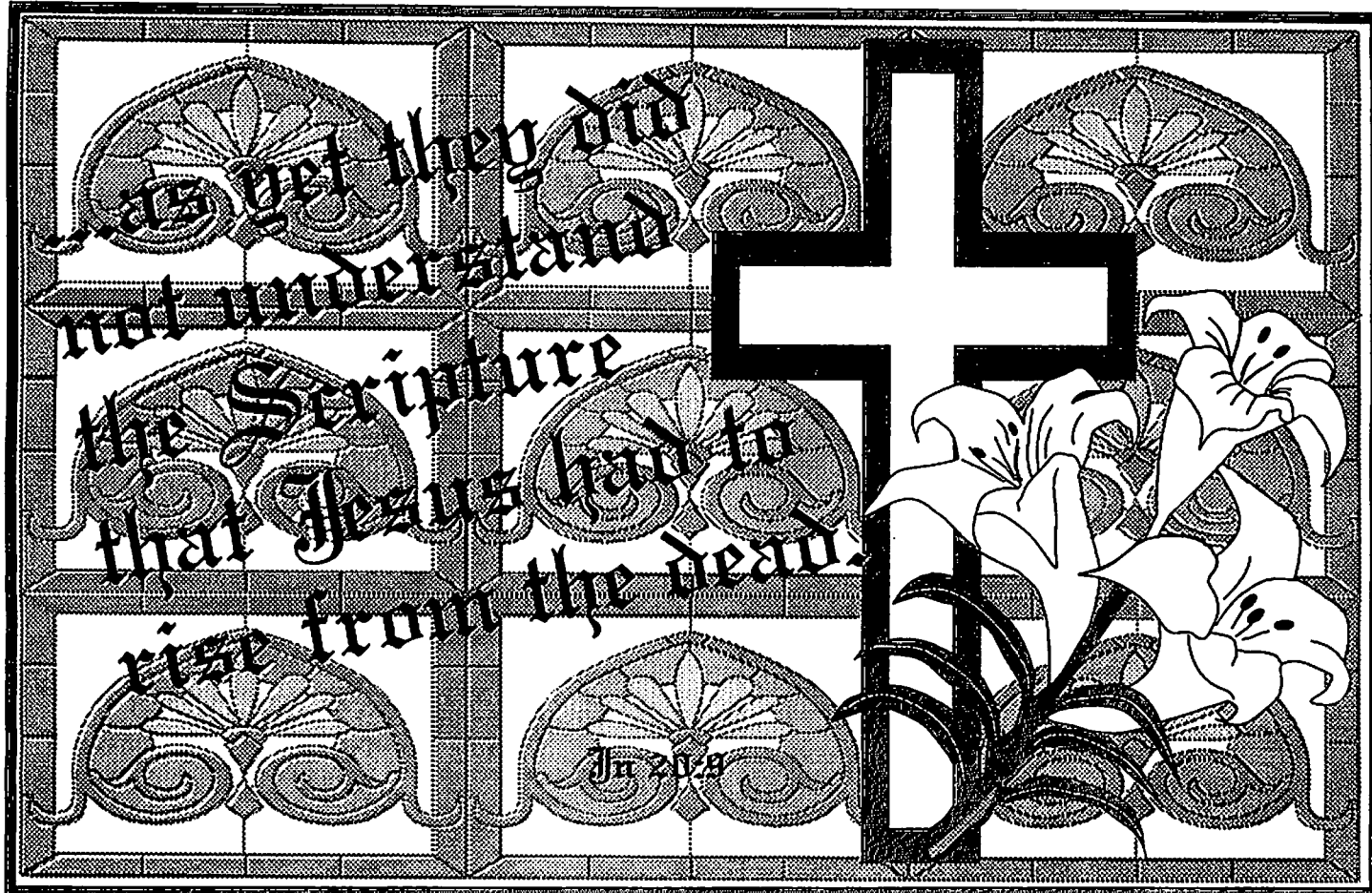
The liturgical year reaches its peak in the Holy Week celebrations. Called to worship, we actively participate in Jesus' passage through death to life. . . . Passion (Palm) Sunday recalls Jesus' entry into Jerusalem as Messiah and King. . . . The Masses for Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday lead us to contemplate the prophetic foreshadowings of events in Jesus' last days. . . . Holy Thursday's evening Mass of the Lord's Supper reminds us that love and service, signified in the rite of washing of feet, are signs of both the baptismal and ministerial priesthood. . . . Good Friday's liturgy focuses on Jesus' crucifixion. . . . Holy Saturday's ceremonies, which begin with a candle service, affirms Christ's victory over death. . . .
