EXTREME UNCTION: IT'S NOT EXTREME ANYMORE!

Reflections on the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick in the Church Today: Part I

"Father, my mother just died. Can you come over and give her the last rites?" Not too many years ago, this call, spoken by a frantic, frightened and grieving voice, would be common in any parish rectory. At best, the caller would inform the priest that the sick relative or friend was dying, breathing his or her last breaths. In either case, the parish priest would hurry for his car, oil of the sick and/or the Eucharist in hand, ready to offer the "last rites" to the dying and support to the family. In almost every instance, the case was genuinely "extreme," that is, at the very limit. The person was dying or dead. Situations are not much more extreme than that.

While we, as a family of faith, know that it has always been and still is important for the priest and other parish members to be present with the dying and their families, and present with the bereaved after the death of a loved one, we also know that it is important to be with the sick much earlier on.

Jesus did not wait for people to die to offer them health and wholeness. He went to them, he reached out to them in their sickness and restored them. He restored them to health, restored them to the loving arms of their families and friends and restored them to their lives of faithful service in the community.

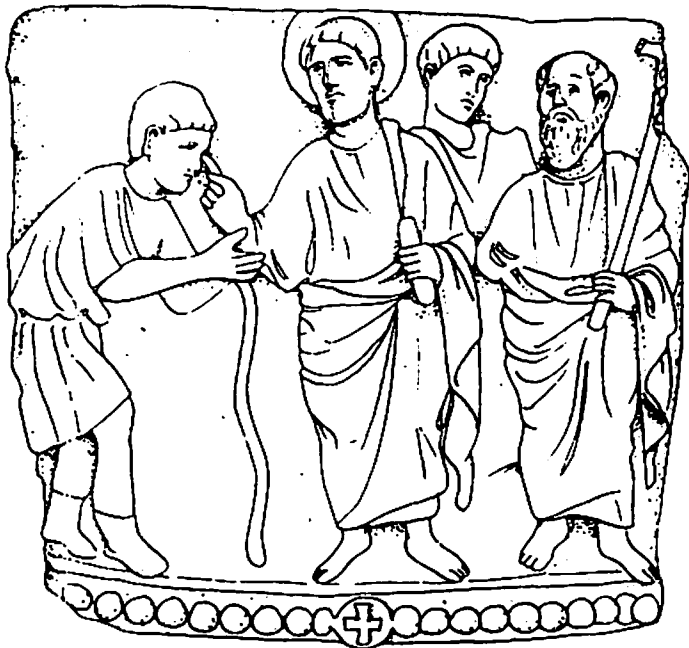
In the liturgical renewal of Vatican II, this sacrament called "Extreme Unction" underwent a wonderful transformation: it was no longer to be an anointing of the dying, but truly an anointing of the sick – preferably celebrated at the beginning of any serious illness. Why this change? The answer lies in Scripture itself:

Are there any who are sick among you?
Let them send for the priests of the Church, and let the priests pray over them, anointing them with oil in the name of the Lord; and the prayer of faith will save the sick persons, and the Lord will raise them up; and if they have committed any sins, their sins will be forgiven them. (James 5:13-15)

In the Church today, we celebrate what is now called the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick at the beginning of any serious illness or before any life-endangering surgery because the prayers of the rite are primarily prayers for healing, prayers for recovery of full health, recovery to full life in and with our community of faith. Yes, this is a major shift in our practice of this sacrament, and that change even in the name of the sacrament reflects that shift clearly and appropriately.

These are the very words of the rite said by the priest as he anoints the sick: "Through this holy anointing, may the Lord in his love and mercy help you with the grace of the Holy Spirit. May the Lord who frees you from sin save you and raise you up."

All through his public ministry, as an essential part of his ministry, Jesus raised up the sick. His message was that the Kingdom of God brought reconciliation and wholeness. The Kingdom brings people together, and the Kingdom brings them together to serve needs of all. Reconciliation and wholeness are the Kingdom message and the Kingdom mission. Jesus "spoke to them of the reign of God, and he healed all who were in need of healing" (Luke 9:11). If we are to be faithful followers,



we must bring those gifts of healing to the sick among us. Yes, we believe that we are sent by Jesus to heal in his name and we believe that "signs will accompany those who have professed their faith . . . and the sick upon whom they lay their hands will recover" (Mark 16:17-18). By being present to celebrate this sacrament at the beginning of an illness, before life-threatening surgery, we make these words of Christ real and active in the lives of the sick today.

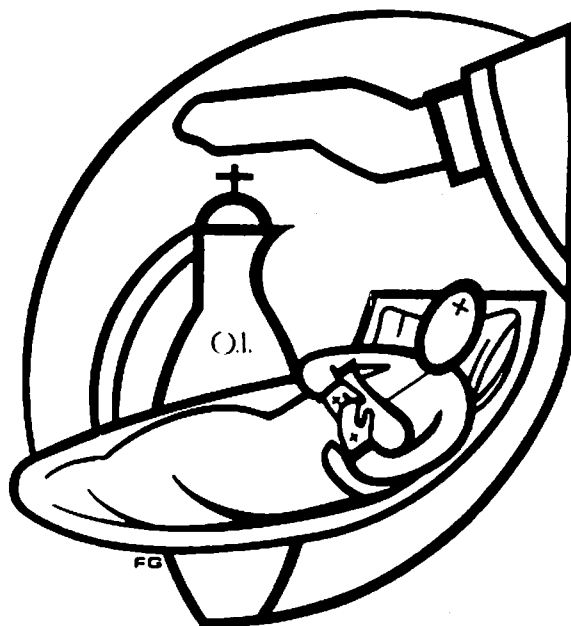
We have something to give to the sick: our prayerful and active support in their time of need, the assurance of our faith that Christ is with them, that we are with them in Christ, the belief that Christ's healing power can and will touch their minds, their hearts, their bodies and make them whole.

Also, we know that the sick have something to give to us: their living example of fidelity, perseverance, courage and hope even in the face of illness. In baptism, they died with Christ, the Christ crucified. Now in their sickness they are living witnesses to us that even pain can be redeemed. They truly understand the words of St. Paul and, with him, pledge to fill up in their own flesh up for what is lacking in the sufferings of Christ for the sake of His body, the Church.

This is an essential and important exchange of gifts, and one that we cannot wait to do only in the "extreme," the very last moments of life. The revised rite of the Anointing of the Sick allows us to celebrate this sacramental gift in the regular, not the extreme moments of our community's life.

Is it wrong to call the priest when someone has died or is breathing their last? Absolutely not! Viaticum (the Eucharist with special prayers for the journey from this life for the life of heaven) is the genuine "last rite" of our Church and we most certainly do wish to bring the Bread of Life to the dying. We most certainly do want to be with bereaved family and friends at and shortly after the death of a loved one. There are prayers for the deceased and for the family that we can pray together. There are other actions of care and support we are ready to give. It is good to call at those times.

Now it is also good to call for the Anointing of the Sick early in a serious illness, so that we can bring to them the assurance that their suffering is not "useless" or without meaning, that they are not removed from the minds, the hearts, the daily activity and life of our community, that we are with them in their need and pray with them and for them that the healing hand of Christ will touch them and restore them to us.

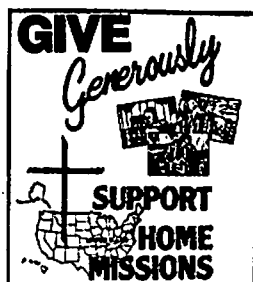

DOING THE RITE "RIGHT"

Reflections on the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick in the Church Today: Part II

Who should receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick? The General Introduction of the rite tells us that these people should: "those of the faithful whose health is seriously impaired by sickness or old age" (paragraph 8). In addition, "a sick person may be anointed before surgery whenever a serious illness is the reason for the surgery. Elderly people may be anointed if they have become notably weakened even though no serious illness is present. Sick children may be anointed if they have sufficient use of reason to be strengthened by this sacrament" (paragraphs 10, 11, 12).

Because this sacrament gives the peace and comfort of the Holy Spirit; because our prayerful support in this sacrament can support and even strengthen the faith, courage and hope of the sick; because their trust in Christ shown by their participation in this sacrament will sustain them in their time of struggle against anxiety, fear, depression; for all these reasons we begin to see that anyone facing a serious illness should request this sacrament. What if you're simply not sure if your illness is "serious" enough? Ask your parish priest. He will be happy to speak with you, to discern with you whether this sacrament is important for you at this stage of your journey of faith. Here is what the Church says about this discernment:

A prudent or reasonably sure judgement, without scruple, is sufficient for deciding on the seriousness of an illness; if necessary a doctor may be consulted. (paragraph 8)

The Lord loved the sick. He cared for them. He went out of his way to heal them. He brought to them the gifts of peace, reconciliation, wholeness. He has entrusted those gifts to us to be shared generously.

If a decision is made not to share in this sacrament at this time, don't forget that there are other sacramental actions of care for the sick: the Eucharist and the sacrament of Penance. These are our regular encounters with the reconciliation and healing of Christ. The sick may wish to share in these sacraments more frequently during their illness, and we are ready to serve them!

For those who do wish to be anointed in this sacrament, let's look at the rite that will be celebrated. This sacrament may be celebrated in the home of the sick person, in a hospital or institution, or in church. There are some parishes that celebrate this sacrament regularly in the parish church, either at a regularly-scheduled Sunday Masses or at a special liturgy. This is a fine practice, and one that the rite itself encourages. To make the effort to have such celebrations regularly reflects our Church's dedication to care for the sick. Such celebrations can fittingly be celebrated during the Season of the Year when the gospel pericopes speak of the public ministry of Jesus and his care for the sick. Such a celebration would be the gospel-in-action for those present at the liturgy.

However, the needs of the sick may more often require that the rite be celebrated in the home of

the sick outside Mass. This rite follows the format of a Liturgy of the Word with the Anointing and Holy Communion as part of the liturgy.

This is the outline of the rite:

INTRODUCTORY RITE

- Greeting
- Sprinkling with Holy Water
- Instruction
- Penitential Rite

LITURGY OF THE WORD

- Reading
- Response

LITURGY OF ANOINTING

- Litany
- Laying on of Hands
- Prayer over the Oil
- Anointing
- Prayer after Anointing
- The Lord's Prayer

LITURGY OF HOLY COMMUNION

- Communion
- Silent Prayer
- Prayer after Communion

CONCLUDING RITE

- Blessing

As at Mass, there are several options for the priest to use in the greeting, the penitential rite or the sprinkling with holy water, the prayers and the reading(s). The Introduction to the rite encourages the priest to meet with the person to be anointed in advance and to select the most suitable readings with that person, for this will allow all the power, hope and peace of the Word of God to speak to that person in her/his illness. As with any liturgy, the options selected must be chosen with care and with an awareness of and sensitivity to those celebrating the rite.

In order for the rite to reflect the prayerful support of the whole Church, it is most important that other members of the faithful join the sick person and the priest for this sacramental celebration. Whenever possible, the

sacrament should be celebrated at a time when other members of the family can be present with the sick person. In many parishes, even for celebrations in the home, the parish priest might invite a parish lector to be present to proclaim the Word of God, special ministers of the Eucharist who do or will minister to this person should be invited and perhaps even a parish cantor, for there is even simple music that can be sung to enhance and express the prayerful faith and hope that brings this assembly together. There is no better way for the sick to feel a part of the Church than to have the Church, through ministers and assembly, present with them to join in prayer as a pledge of support and service. Following the example of Jesus and the example of the early Church, we readily bring to the sick this living reality of Church, this encounter with Christ's kingdom through kingdom prayer and kingdom people.

When the anointing of the sick is celebrated at Mass, the elements are the same as listed above, and follow the regular order of Mass, with the Liturgy of Anointing beginning after the readings and homily.

There are two powerful symbols of this rite, the laying on of hands and the anointing with the Oil of the Sick, and we will discuss those in our next "Reflections."

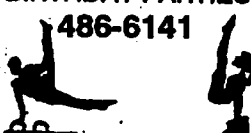

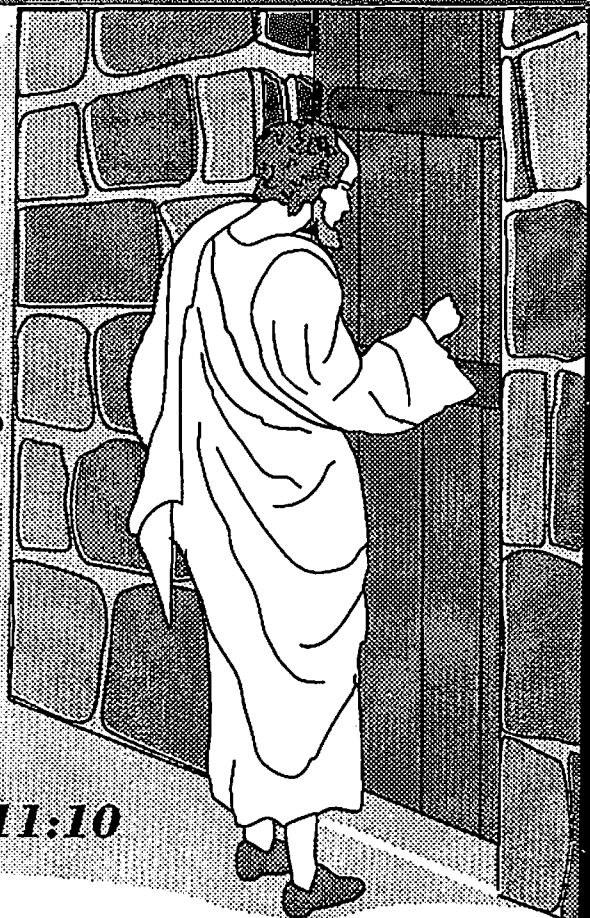

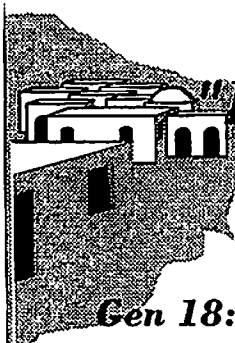

At the Masses this weekend in our church, a representative of the Diocese of Jacmel, Haiti, will conduct an appeal for this diocese. On February 27, 1988, this diocese was created from the Archdiocese of Port-Au-Prince, the capitol of Haiti. The new diocese has a population of 500,000 with fourteen parishes and 109 chapels. Each of the parishes has at least two parochial schools and they are supported by the church. People are mostly farmers and the parents are too poor to pay tuition. In September 1988, Hurricane Gilbert struck and the church is still working to rebuild the church and school buildings destroyed then. This takes time and money. There are 30 seminarians and it takes \$25,000 to support and educate them. And a like amount is spent for catechists. In the diocese there are 25 priests and many have no income. Your help is needed just to help these people survive - and to educate more priests and catechists.

Your usual generous response certainly would be gratefully appreciated.

SIGNS OF LOVE, STRENGTH AND HEALING

Reflections on the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick in the Church Today: Part III

The liturgy is celebrated with "signs and symbols perceptible to the senses" through which the love of Christ and the action of Christ in the lives of people are made real. These signs convey how Christ acts in our lives, they clearly reflect how Christ loves us, draws us to himself and transforms us in and through the liturgy.

There are two powerful and clear signs used in the celebration of the Anointing of the Sick: the laying on of hands and the anointing with the Oil of the Sick. Both are worth discussing.

This is the biblical gesture of healing. It is Jesus' own customary gesture for healing: "They brought the sick with various diseases to him, and he laid hands on every one of them and healed them" (Luke 4:40).

The laying on of hands is one of the oldest of our prayer gestures, used even before the words "sacrament" or "liturgy" came into the Church's language. The laying on of hands is a ritualized form of embrace, a taking the person to oneself. It is also a sign of the passing on of power, of designation or deputation.

In the passing on of the power of the Holy Spirit to the newly-selected deacons, the apostles laid hands on them. The Spirit in which the apostles shared was passed on through this bodily contact. The new deacons visibly became one with the apostles in their ministry in the name of Christ. This is the same gesture used today in ordinations of bishops, priests and deacons.

The laying on of hands is also used in the sacrament of Penance. Again, it shows the gift of the Holy Spirit in pardon and peace and a passing on of the strength of the Spirit so that this person may have the strength to "go and sin no more," as Jesus told Mary Magdalene.

So, too, in the anointing of the sick the priest lays hands on the head of the sick person. The healing power of the Spirit is shared, the peace that comes from forgiveness and reconciliation are conveyed in a rich sign of embrace.

The Introduction to the rite says that,

The ritual [of the Anointing of the Sick] has restored to a major significance the gesture of the laying on of hands with its several meanings. With this gesture the priest indicates that this particular person is the object of the Church's prayer of faith. The laying on of hands is clearly a sign of blessing, as we pray that by the power of God's healing grace the sick person may be restored to health or at least strengthened in time of illness. (paragraph 106)

The second powerful sign of this sacrament is the oil of the sick, used in the anointing. The oil used in this liturgy is, preferably, the oil blessed by the Bishop of the diocese at the Chrism Mass during or near Holy Week. With his priests and deacons with him and faithful gathered from throughout the diocese, the bishop blesses the oil that will be used in sacramental celebrations for that following year. As he blesses the oil, the bishop prays,

Send the Holy Spirit, man's Helper and Friend,
upon this oil . . .
May your blessing come upon this oil,
that they may be freed from pain and illness
and made well again in body, mind, and soul ...

Oil is a rich symbol for the action of this sacrament. Mark Searle offers this poetic reflection on the value of oil:

Oil applied ahead of time
 seals the skin against its enemies --
 sun and water, wind and cold;
 gives the fighter a fighting chance
 to slide and squirm elusively
 evading capture and k.o.
 Oil applied remedially
 repairs the wounds of war and work,
 chapped, cracked, broken skin
 salved and soothed,
 unguent for wound and rash
 for scrape and scrofula...
 poured, smeared, daubed, rubbed in:
 liniment of the spirit,
 healing balm.

(Assembly, Vol. 8, No. 1,
 September, 1981)

Oil is used so often for its medicinal value that this blessed oil serves as a true sign of the healing of the Holy Spirit. St. Tertullian said that "the flesh is anointed that the soul may be consecrated." The flesh of the sick is anointed that the spirit of the sick person may be strengthened by the healing Spirit. The body is anointed that Christ's healing mercy may be felt.

The priest anoints the forehead and the hands of the sick person, as he prays the sacramental form. The Introduction of the rite is careful to point out that,

If the anointing is to be an effective sacramental symbol, there should be a generous use of oil so that it will be seen and felt by the sick person as a sign of the Spirit's healing and strengthening presence. (paragraph 107)

When the sacrament is celebrated at Mass for a number of sick, several priests might participate in the celebration as concelebrants of the sacrament. In those celebrations, each priest lays hands on some of the sick and anoints those same persons. In communal celebrations, it is fitting that the assembly join in suitable songs while the sick are being anointed. This is a sign of the whole community's support for the sick, a support that we know we must and that we want to give.

Father Thomas Richstatter, O.F.M. in an article

in Catholic Update supports what has been said already, specifically that,

In the liturgy our sanctification is brought about by signs perceptible to the senses . . . It is especially through the act of signifying that a sacrament is a channel of God's grace. Signs are both given and received. In the Sacrament of the Sick a sign is given by the Church to the sick person, and the one who is sick gives a sign to the community. The care and concern of the community is a sign to the sick person of the Lord's own great concern for the bodily and spiritual welfare of the sick. We who are the Body of Christ must continue to proclaim the Kingdom of wholeness and salvation in word and deed. We are to be a Church of healing and reconciliation. The celebration of the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is a ritual moment which makes visible and present to the sick and the whole community an image of who we are as Church, that is, a community of mutual healing and support. (Catholic Update, CU 0584, copyright 1984, St. Anthony Messenger Press)

MISSIONARY COOPERATIVE APPEAL

At the Masses this weekend in our church, a representative of the Diocese of Jacmel, Haiti, will conduct an appeal for this diocese. On February 27, 1988, this diocese was created from the Archdiocese of Port-Au-Prince, the capitol of Haiti. The new diocese has a population of 500,000 with fourteen parishes and 109 chapels. Each of the parishes has at least two parochial schools and they are supported by the church. People are mostly farmers and the parents are too poor to pay tuition. In September 1988, Hurricane Gilbert struck and the church is still working to rebuild the church and school buildings destroyed then. This takes time and money. There are 30 seminarians and it takes \$25,000 to support and educate them. And a like amount is spent for catechists. In the diocese there are 25 priests and many have no income. Your help is needed just to help these people survive - and to educate more priests and catechists.

Your usual generous response certainly would be greatly appreciated.

A SOURCE OF STRENGTH AND JOY

Reflections on the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick in the Church Today: Part IV

Bishop Stanley Ott, Bishop of Baton Rouge, has been a priest for forty years. In his pastoral ministry in both New Orleans and Baton Rouge, he has certainly had the opportunity to celebrate the sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick many times for the people of the parishes he served in as a priest and the people of the Diocese of Baton Rouge as their bishop.

Reflecting on one of the more memorable experiences of this sacrament, Bishop Ott shares this story:

"My most memorable experience with the sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick was with a man dying of cancer who had been away from the Church for many years. During my first visits with him, he resisted the sacraments of anointing, confession and communion. Only three days before his death, his wife called for me to come. I did and gave him the anointing of the sick, confession and communion. He died three days later in my arms. It was a very moving experience of the peace of reconciliation of someone coming back to God through the love of the Church."

Every priest could certainly tell a similar story, for they have all seen with their own eyes and felt in their own hearts what this sacrament brings over and over again. The experience of the love of God. The experience of the care of the Church. Reconciliation. Peace.

There is an even more touching story to be told to us by Bishop Ott about this sacrament. It is his own experience of being anointed. In the Spring of 1991, Bishop Ott was diagnosed as having a sarcoma on the liver. It was suggested that there be a celebration of the Anointing at St. Joseph Cathedral and that all of the priests of his diocese participate in the anointing.

"At first I was surprised," Bishop Ott recalls. "I was not surprised that the anointing was being suggested as I knew I had a serious illness. I was surprised in that it had not occurred to me that the priests of the diocese might want to anoint me ... That so many of the priests might want to anoint me during my time of illness really touched me deeply."

"I was very pleased to be anointed ... It was a very touching moment for me ... one of the graces of my anointing was to experience the support of the Church, both through the clergy and so many of the laity who I know are praying for me."

How did the bishop know the caring presence of Christ? Through the very liturgy of the anointing:

"What I remember most is the way the readings, prayers and music all became a symphony of prayer. It was a rich liturgical experience. I know that not every anointing can be this way, but the power is there to speak deeply to the sick person of the Lord's love for him/her through the prayer of the Church."

Even though every anointing is not celebrated in such a large communal setting as was Bishop Ott's, the elements of the same rich symphony of prayer are there: the proclamation of God's Word in the readings of Scripture, the presence of the Church's ministers in the priest and his assisting ministers, the prayers of healing in the rite, the anointing with the soothing Oil of the Sick and music, all are there to bring to each person who is ill the experience of the healing hand and reconciling heart of Christ.

A family from Lafayette was planning a vacation in Las Vegas, Nevada and the wife's mother, with the approval of their family doctor,

accompanied them. While on vacation, the elderly lady became ill and was hospitalized. The condition was serious and a priest of the area was called in to celebrate the Anointing of the Sick. It was a Saturday afternoon and the rest of the family had hoped to participate in the anticipated liturgy in the neighboring parish. The elderly lady's daughter recalls, "We were scared out of our minds to leave her because she actually seemed comatose," but went to Mass to pray again for her, "with heavy hearts." They knew the Lord was very real and very near to her, she recalls. When they returned to the hospital, there her mother was, sitting up in bed, looking more spry than before.

While not everyone experiences this immediate and profound healing, all can experience and share the great consolation and sense of hope that both the sick woman and her family knew in this sacrament.

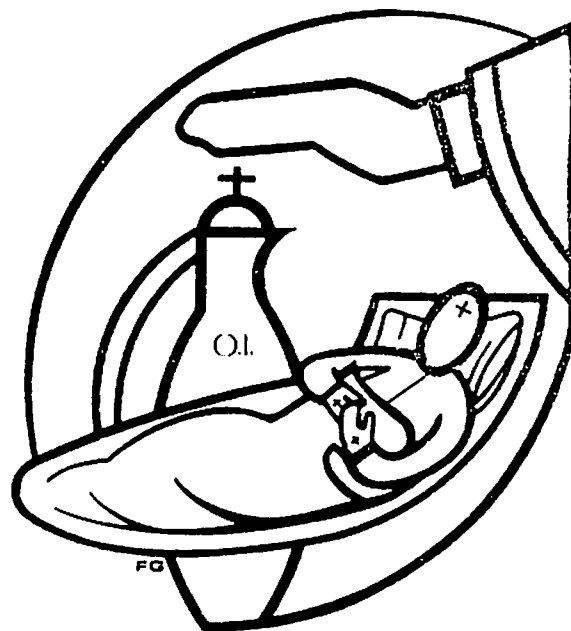
Another woman in a parish in New Orleans reflects on her experience of this sacrament at a communal celebration in her parish church. "I did not receive healing of my illness, but I did feel a real peace after being anointed," she says. She recalls how the prayer of the whole community, the support she felt from them lifted part of the burden of her illness even though a physical healing was not present at that moment. But support, renewed courage, a deeper sense of community support, these are experiences of strength that the Lord also gives through the community in this sacrament.

The rite of Pastoral Care of the Sick recommends that each parish celebrate the communal Anointing of the Sick on a regular basis: during the seasons of Advent/Christmas and Lent/Easter. We, the bishops of the State, add our encouragement to this. By making these liturgies a regular part of our community liturgies, we manifest our true concern for the sick, we make this rich sacramental experience readily available for the sick and permit the sick to be an example for us of perseverance, courage and faith.

In this communal celebration we receive from them the example of fidelity. They receive from us what Bishop Ott tells us he experienced, and which so many others testify as well: "It has been a source of strength and joy in my life.

This is one sacrament that always seems to bring a special strength. This sacrament is an instrument in the hands of God to bring special peace to those seriously ill."

When we dedicate ourselves to celebrating this sacrament regularly and prayerfully, it will continue to be an experience of the love of Christ and Christ's Church. It will continue to be an experience of forgiveness. Through this experience, the sick will find comfort, strength, hope, compassion and courage. They will find in Christ and through us the strength to face their illness. They will know they are never alone, that nothing will separate them from the love of Christ. They will know Christ loves them. They will know we care for them. Through this gift of love and presence they will be healed in body and in spirit. It will come to them in the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick, this rich symphony of prayer, the prayer of the Church.

DID I UNDERSTAND YOU TO SAY THAT . . . ?

Reflections on the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick in the Church Today: Part V

We conclude this series of reflections on the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick by answering some common questions asked about it.

Who may receive this sacrament?

Any Catholic whose health is impaired due to serious illness or old age or any Catholic who is preparing for life-threatening surgery.

Just how "serious" does this have to be?

There is no one, clear, absolute answer to this question. We know that not all illness is "serious." Daily aches and pains, tension headaches, a toothache, a sprained wrist all hurt, but we know they are most often not "serious." Nonetheless, the new rite encourages us not to be as restrictive as we had been in the past. The rite encourages us not to be scrupulous about this determination. Whenever in doubt, discuss this with your pastor; he will be happy to discern with you your need for this sacrament.

Does mental illness qualify as "serious"?

Yes, it does. "Some types of mental sickness are now classified as serious. Those who are judged to have a serious mental illness and who would be strengthened by the sacrament may be anointed" (paragraph 53). Again, the best approach is to discuss the situation with your pastor.

May a child be anointed?

Yes. A child who has reached the age of reason (the age of First Eucharist), who would be consoled and strengthened by the sacrament

may be anointed. (paragraph 12) For children below the age of reason, the rite of Pastoral Care of the Sick has others prayers and Scripture readings that the priest would offer with and for the child and that child's family.

May a person be anointed more than once?

Yes. If the illness worsens, a person may be anointed again. If a person recuperates and then falls ill again, the anointing may also be celebrated again. (paragraph 9)

If I will be anointed in my home, is there anything I need to prepare?

Very little. The priest and his assisting ministers will usually bring what is needed. It is important that you try to select an area where the priest, his assisting ministers and your family can join with you for this prayer. Make sure the television or radio is off. The anointing with oil is on the forehead and the hands, so you might be prepared for this. It would be helpful to have a small table covered with a white cloth for the priest to place the Eucharist and the Oil of the Sick on during the sacrament.

Is Communion always part of the anointing?

Not always, but usually. The Eucharist is the central sacrament; it is a sacrament of strength, healing and forgiveness and so it is more desirable that these two sacraments be celebrated together.

Do I have to go to Confession before I am anointed?

The constant teaching of our Church is that the sacrament of Penance is required only for those in the state of serious, deadly ("mortal") sin. Forgiveness of all other sin is part of the

sacrament of Penance is required only for those in the state of serious, deadly ("mortal") sin. Forgiveness of all other sin is part of the sacraments of the Eucharist and the Anointing. So that others may participate with you in the sacrament of Anointing, if you do wish to receive the sacrament of Penance, the priest should preferably visit with you for this earlier. (paragraph 101)

I have heard about members of prayer groups anointing the sick with oil. Is this the same as the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick?

No, it is not. Only bishops or priests may celebrate this sacrament with the sick. The oil used is the oil blessed by the bishop of the diocese at the Chrism Mass during or near Holy Week. The Book of Blessings (numbers 1785-1804) does have a blessing of oil that may be used by lay persons to bless the sick. This oil would first be blessed by a priest. A blessing with this oil by a lay person is not the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. It is another facet of the Church's care for the sick and our prayer with them, but should never be confused with or take the place of the Sacrament for those who are seriously ill. It would certainly be incumbent upon a lay minister to explain the difference in these anointings to the sick person and those caring for this person. If there might be any confusion on the part of the sick person, the person leading the prayer could also use the "Blessings of the Sick" in the Book of Blessings (numbers 376-406) that do not have an anointing as part of that service.

Does everyone who celebrates the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick experience healing?

Fr. Robert Melancon offers this response in a recent article in The Bayou Catholic:

My answer is a resounding YES! As long as you understand that healing can refer to physical healing as well as a spiritual healing or a psychological healing. Ask anyone who has been anointed, and speak to them about what happened to them during the sacrament. See if they don't say that they felt a healing, whether of mind or body. Often, the stories they tell are wonderful and are about unexplainable healings. The sacrament is not a substitute for the work of doctors and nurses, drugs and hospitals. God's

healing power works through the hands and intelligence of medical professionals, and we should pray that God guide them also.

We pray in the sacrament that the sick would be healed in body, in mind and in spirit. God knows more than we do what healing you might need most: that a wound be healed; that a fear turn to confidence; that loneliness disappear into the support of a praying Church; that puzzlement in the face of all the why's – WHY me, WHY suffering, WHY now – may turn into insight.
