### LENTEN REGULATIONS FOR FAST AND ABSTINENCE

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of abstinence from meat and also days of fast. All Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence.

To abstain means to refrain from eating meat; to fast means to limit oneself to one full meal and two lighter meals in the course of a day. The obligation to abstain binds Catholics 14 years of age and older. The obligation to fast binds Catholics who are at least 18 and have not yet reached the age of 59. (Those who are ill are not obligated to fast.)

Fasting and abstaining are forms of penance. There is a frequent question about the degree of seriousness of the matter. The teaching on this matter may be summarized thusly: the obligation to do penance is a serious one; the obligation to observe the penitential days specified by the Church is also serious. No one should be scrupulous in this regard; failure to observe individual days of penance is not considered serious; rather it is the failure to observe any penitential days at all or a substantial number of such days which must be considered serious.

Dear Monsignor Kern:

Over the past few weeks, I have received in excess of 70,000 letters and postcards from constituents expressing their strong opposition to the Freedom of Choice Act. To avoid the costs that would accrue to the taxpayers if I answered all of these letters individually, I am contacting you to let you know of my views on this issue in the hope that you will pass them on to those in your congregation who may be interested. Some among them may have written to let me know they are deeply and personally concerned over this issue.

Throughout my tenure in the Senate, I have consistently supported the "right to life" position. I have been a strong critic of the 1973 Supreme Court decision legalizing abortion -- I believe it was wrong. Furthermore, I have also supported efforts to prevent the use of taxpayers' dollars for abortion and abortion related services. I am opposed to the Freedom of Choice Act.

Dear Monsignor Kern:

Many members of your congregation have contacted me concerning the Freedom of Choice Act which has been introduced in Congress. Due to the volume of mail I received on this subject and my desire to respond as quickly as possible, I would like to solicit your help in making my views known to your congregation.

As you are aware, I have been a member of either the House of Representatives or the Senate for almost 21 years and I have always supported pro-life legislation. In fact, for many years, I have cosponsored an amendment to the Constitution that would guarantee the right to life for all children. Much of the recent activity in Congress on the abortion issue has dealt with the use of federal funds to promote or pay for the abortion services, counseling, etc. I want you to know that I have always voted to oppose the use of taxpayers' money to, in any way, promote or encourage abortion.

While a vote on the Freedom of Choice Act has not been scheduled at this time, I am pleased to inform you that I will vote against this bill when it is presented to the Senate. I have looked at the proposed legislation and find that contrary to some arguments, this bill goes much further than the Roe v. Wade decision. You may be assured I will keep your and your congregation's concerns in mind when this bill is voted on. I appreciate your sharing my views with them.

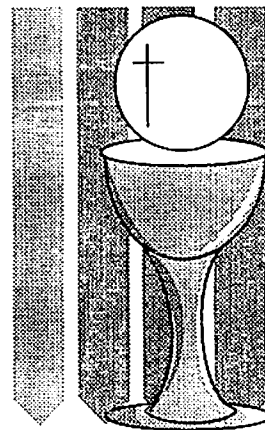

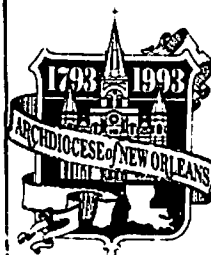


