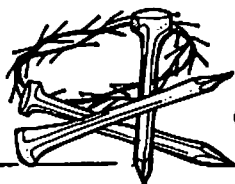

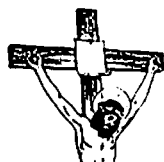

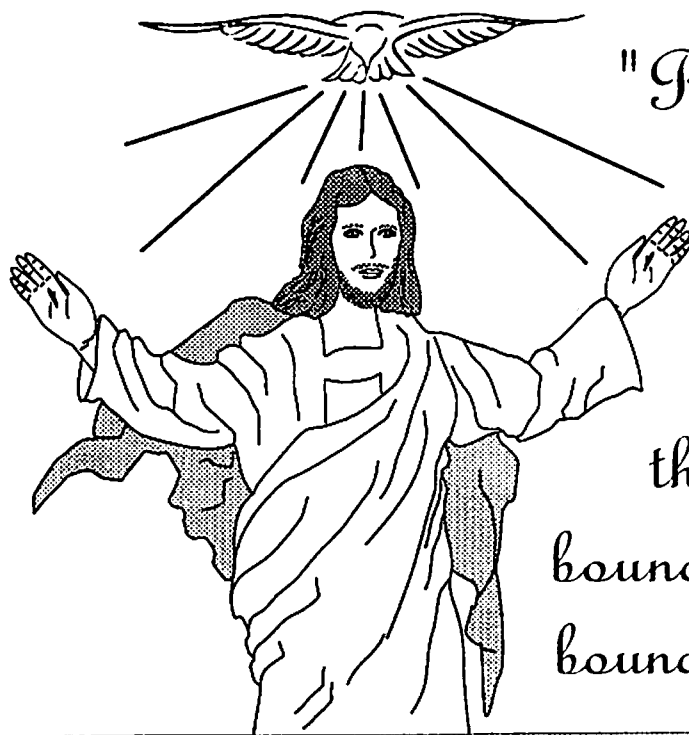
PRAYER FOR SUNDAY, APRIL 11 EASTER SUNDAY

Holy Days of Obligation: Special Days for Celebration

Part I

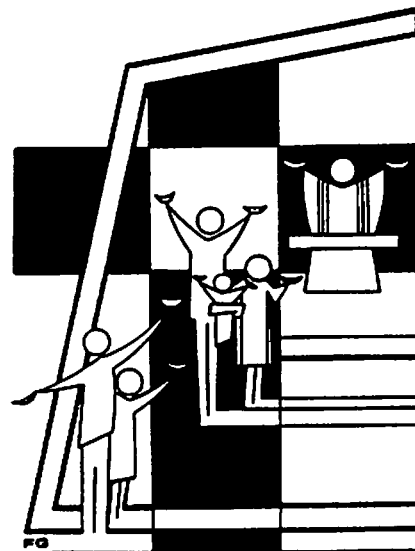
The author Alex Haley in his landmark works Roots and Queen not only traced his own family roots and those of the African American community in the United States, he sparked in the minds and hearts of people of all ethnic and national origins the desire to know "where they came from," the desire to be in touch with their own family origins. The great and on-going popularity of that author's work, the on-going phenomenon of people researching their family history and their family tree speaks of our desire to know our past, for we know that our heritage helps us to understand who we are today. This knowledge also helps us to shape our future, as we become more aware of our family values, traditions and customs and pass these on to those who will follow us.

We in the Catholic community have embraced the value of this rootedness from our very beginnings. The dioceses of our Church, established throughout the world, name a patron saint, one who gives us rootedness in our tradition. Parishes, in turn, are named after a saint. Children and adults, at the celebration of their baptism, are given a Christian name -- a person of proven, committed faith for them to emulate and a name to link them with our Christian family heritage. In the Nicene Creed, which we pray at Mass on Sundays and Solemnities, we profess our belief in the "communion of saints." We believe that we are one family, one holy family in Christ. We profess that this family goes beyond the confines of space and time. It includes the holy ones of all times and all places. The saints in heaven and the holy ones on earth are united in prayerful support and active concern of one another. Our roots run deep. Our heritage is

precious. It is real.

There have been and still are in our Catholic tradition, special days that our family of faith celebrates. Sunday is, of course, our first and foremost day of family prayer. Christians have celebrated Sunday as the commemoration of Christ's resurrection from the very beginnings of our history. This is attested to in the Scriptures and in this record from the writings of St. Justin the Martyr (c. 150 A.D.):

On the day named after the sun, all who live in city or countryside assemble. The memoirs of the apostles or the writings of the prophets are read for as long as time allows. When the lector has finished, the president addresses us and exhorts us to imitate the splendid things we have heard. Then we all stand and pray. When we have finished praying, bread, wine and water are brought up. The president then prays and gives thanks according to his ability, and the people give their assent with an "Amen!" Next, the gifts over which the thanksgiving has been spoken are distributed and everyone shares in them



This is how the early Christians remembered the Lord, as they had been told by him to do so. This is how they celebrated and entered into the mystery of Christ's resurrection. This is how they celebrated their identity in Christ. This is how they professed and deepened their union with this community of believers. Sunday was their family day, and so they gathered.

We maintain that great and cherished tradition. We are rooted in Christ. We hear him speak to us in the proclamation of the Scriptures and see him in the breaking of the bread. Every Sunday is a holy day for us, as we celebrate that, through the Eucharist, we rise with Christ to a life that is transformed and redeemed. Every Sunday is a holy day, when we rest from our routine labors to find refreshment for mind and body in our Lord, the source and goal of all our life.

In addition to Sunday, there are other days that are special to us in this family of faith. They have been celebrated from very early in the history of the Church. Feasts of the Blessed Virgin Mary, the Apostles and other saints help us to see the larger family of faith to which we belong, for they honor and celebrate Christ our brother and other important persons in our family of faith.

In celebrating these days, we come to know the fullness of God's love as it came to us in the dying and rising of Jesus. In celebrating these days, we come to know the ready gift of our salvation in Christ. In celebrating these days, we reflect on others who have gone before us and how they heard and responded to Christ. In celebrating these days, we profit from their example, we identify ourselves as part of the family of faith in which they played a significant role, we honor them and, through them, give honor to God for their lives and their example.

This is a rich heritage indeed. It is also

one which sets us apart as Catholics. These days, these "holy days" are opportunities for us to witness to others the faith that means so much to us: so much that we make the added effort to participate in the celebration of the Eucharist at Mass. We show that our lives are always to be a sacrifice of praise to God, as were the lives of these people and this community we celebrate and honor.

So important are these days to us in our tradition that they have been days which required Mass attendance by all members of the Catholic Church. We would not know who we are without these days. We would not know fully what makes us Catholic, what being part of this family means. These "are our family gatherings at which we learn, celebrate and give thanks to God for the genuine blessing of our Catholic faith.

The universal Church holds these days as our major feast days, as stated in the Code of Canon Law, canon 1246: the Nativity of Our Lord (Christmas), the Epiphany, the Ascension and the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, Holy Mary Mother of God and her Immaculate Conception and Assumption, Saint Joseph, the Apostles Peter and Paul, and All Saints.

It is the responsibility of the Conference of Catholic Bishops in each nation to determine which of these days will be days of obligatory Mass attendance in that country. In our next article, we will discuss the days so designated by the Bishops of the United States and their celebration here in the Archdiocese of New Orleans.

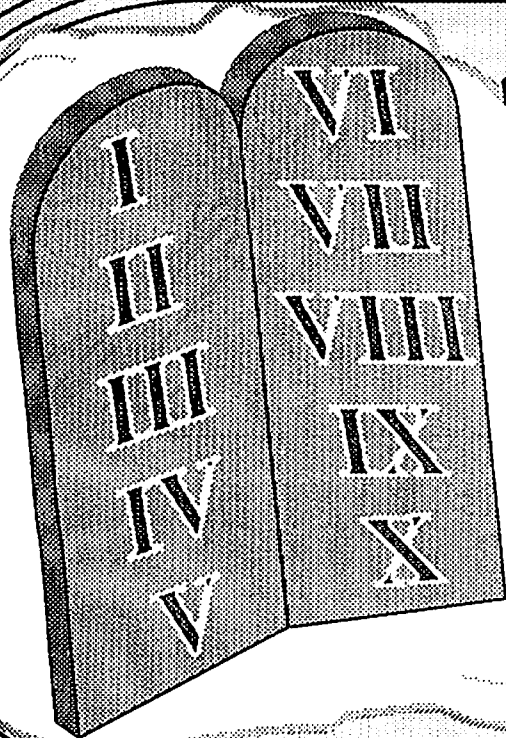

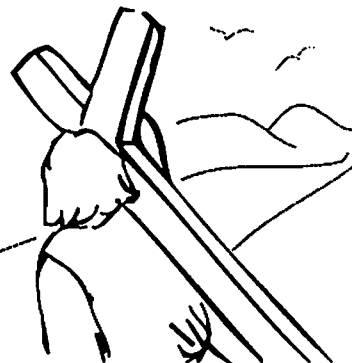

Holy Days of Obligation: Special Days for Celebration

Part II

*Through his cross and resurrection
Christ has freed us from sin and death
and called us to the glory that has made us
a chosen race, a royal priesthood,
a holy nation, a people set apart.*

These words, based on the words of Sacred Scripture, are prayed in one of the Sunday Prefaces at Mass. We pray them because we believe them. We pray them so that we may be shaped by them. We, in this Catholic community, have been chosen by Christ to be a priestly people: to offer a sacrifice of praise to God and the sacrifice of our lives for others. We are set apart. We are committed and commissioned to know the good news, to proclaim it to others, to witness it for others in all that we do. We are to be living signs of Christ's love and presence in this world. We are to be living signs that the salvation, joy and peace of Christ are with us. We are to be living signs that Jesus Christ is Lord of all of us, of all we are, of all we do.

One part of being those living signs is the time we "set apart" for our common worship. Going to Mass is a very public activity: our family, friends and neighbors see us do it. They come to know that this is an essential part of our weekly routine. Worship is a very public way of showing that we belong to God, that we belong to this Catholic community of faith, that it is important to us. Others might think this commitment of ours is foolish, frivolous or wasteful. We do not. We are a people set apart and give the example that worship is essential, serious and worthwhile. It is in the celebration of Eucharist during the course of our liturgical year that allows us to enter into, to know and experience the salvation of Christ that is ours. It is the regular celebration of Mass in the context of

our liturgical year that enables us to center our minds and hearts on Christ. It enables us to place our lives into Christ's and the Church's life. It enables us to participate in the joy of the communion of saints, the community of the redeemed in Christ.

Why are there "holy days of obligation"? Why are we obliged to participate in Mass on these days? Because they are that special to us in our faith tradition. Because they tell us so much about the love of God, the faithfulness of our ancestors in faith. Because they tell us so much about where we have come from and where we are going in our Catholic way of life. These are the reasons why. Parents are "obligated" to care for their family, aren't they? It is because this is a way of expressing love for the life they have brought into being. Family members are "obligated" to participate in special family activities, aren't they? This is so that they can appreciate who their family is and who they are as part of this family. These are obligations we perform out of love. So it is with holy days of obligation. We participate in them out of love for the faith entrusted to us in Baptism. We participate in them out of love for this communion of saints of which we are a part -- an essential part! We participate in them out of love for one another, whose faith we share and support. We should view this not as a negative obligation, not as a burden, but as an opportunity: an opportunity to thank God for the Catholic life we have, an opportunity to enter more deeply into the mystery of Christ's presence in the liturgical year, an opportunity to join in faith-filled communion with our sisters and brothers in Christ, an opportunity to witness to others that these feasts reflect the meaning of and give greater meaning to our lives.

On December 1, 1991, the National Conference of Catholic Bishops of the United States

decreed that these are the holy days of obligation, the special days of celebration, that are to be observed in the United States:

January 1, the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God;

Thursday of the Sixth Week of Easter, the Solemnity of the Ascension;

August 15, the Solemnity of the Assumption;

November 1, the Solemnity of All Saints;

December 8, the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception;

December 25, the Solemnity of the Nativity of Our Lord Jesus Christ.

This decree added that, when certain of these days fall on a Saturday or a Monday, the obligation to participate in Mass is abrogated, that is, dispensed. These days are January 1, August 15 and November 1. However, December 8 and 25 are to be observed as holy days at all times. Why will the feast of the Immaculate Conception always be observed? Because Mary, under this title, is the patronness of our nation, and so this is our special national feast day.

This decree of our National Conference of Bishops was confirmed by the Holy See on July 4, 1992 and is now the law for the Catholic Church in the United States.

Why is the obligation dispensed when three of these feasts fall on Saturday or Monday? This was a pastoral decision made by our bishops. It is partly due to the present practice of celebrating anticipated liturgies of Sunday on Saturday evening and of holy days on the evening before the feast. As a result, a parish may have special Masses for the holy day on Friday evening and Saturday morning, and then Masses for Sunday on Saturday evening and all day on Sunday; or Masses on Saturday evening and Sunday morning for Sunday and on Sunday evening and all day Monday for the holy day. There is often great confusion as to which Mass is for which day. A further pastoral difficulty arises as a result of the "back to back"

celebration of Sunday and a holy day. Since holy days are major celebrations of the Church and are to be given the highest rank in the liturgical calendar, they should be celebrated with due solemnity. However, in practice it is difficult to celebrate both with equal solemnity. An unfortunate result often is the rather perfunctory celebration of the holy day liturgy.

While seeking to be sensitive to these pastoral realities, yet seeking to maintain this venerable tradition of holy days, the obligation was abrogated on the occasions mentioned already.

This does not mean the day is not important. Parishes still should make every effort to celebrate every holy day with great solemnity and with worthy liturgy. Perhaps the number of liturgies on these abrogated days will be lessened, but the quality must remain 'at the liturgies celebrated. Even though the obligation to participate at Mass is dispensed, the feast itself is still celebrated at the Masses offered that day.

On all holy days, parishes are to schedule Masses at convenient hours so that our Catholic people may observe these special days of celebration. Pastors and the ministers who assist them in liturgy preparation and celebration are to make every effort that these Masses are given the extra care and festivity they merit, whether they are days of obligation or not.

Let us seek to approach these festival days in a positive manner, respecting and indeed cherishing them as a public witness to the God, the faith, the Church community we love!

Through the intercession of Our Lady of Prompt Succor, may we be spared of all loss of life and property during this hurricane season, we pray to the Lord.

PRO-LIFE THOUGHT - As assisted suicide proposals continue to appear on state ballots, some question why this option should not exist for the terminally ill.

A study of people with terminal illness published in the American Journal of Psychiatry found that fewer than one in four expressed a will to die and all of those who did had clinically diagnosed depression.

Psychologists in the field note that effective psychotherapeutic treatment is possible with the terminally ill. Thus, compassionate counseling and assistance, such as that provided in many hospices, together with medical and psychological care, can provide a positive alternative to euthanasia for those with terminal illness.
