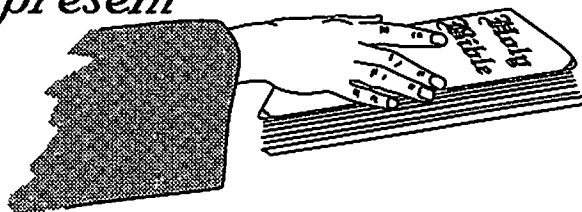

Message from Archbishop Schulte:

The Black & Indian/Home Mission Collection will be conducted on July 18th this year. Since 1885, the Catholic Church in the U.S. has provided assistance for hundreds of priests, sisters and catechists working in African American and Native American communities.

In 1992 the Black & Indian/Home Mission Collection provided six and a half million dollars for evangelization. However, the requests from bishops of 140 dioceses with priests, sisters and others in parishes and missions needing support, was in excess of 15 million dollars.

Cooperation is needed so that the 1993 edition of this collection may be successful. Every Catholic person, regardless of age, may play a part in the evangelization work of the Church by contributing to this collection.
