PRO-LIFE THOUGHT: In an outstanding pamphlet entitled "Mary's Pregnancy," Dr. J. C. Wilke makes the following observations about the earliest stages in the life of Christ which should deeply influence Christian beliefs about abortion: "The story is clear enough. 




