ST. ANGELA PARISHIONER TO CYCLE FOR THE DISABLED -

At Jesuit High School, the motto is "men for others." John M. Whitney III, an LSU student, Jesuit and St. Angela Merici alumnus, will put that motto into action this summer when he and 59 other college students bike cross-country to help disabled people.

The Journey of Hope is an annual endeavor by the Pi Kappa Phi fraternity. To be selected to ride in the journey, an applicant must get faculty recommendations and write an essay on why he is applying.

The journey begins in San Francisco. The riders will bike an average of 75 miles a day and spend their evenings informing people of the difficulties of living with a disability. After a week of touring together, the group will divide into two. One group will take a northern route and Whitney's group will take a southern route which goes through Louisiana. Approximately 3600 miles, 21 states and 160 cities later, the bike teams will reunite in Washington, D.C.

Before embarking on the bike trek, each team member must raise \$4000; the money is used for camps and facilities for disabled people and educational awareness programs. Should you wish to help John reach this goal, send your donation to the Rectory and it will be forwarded to him.

LENTEN FAST AND ABSTINENCE

1. Fasting is to be observed on Ash Wednesday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59. Those who are bound to fast may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to each one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.
2. Abstinence from meat is to be observed by all Catholics 14 years or older on Ash Wednesday and on all Fridays of Lent.
3. The determination of certain days as obligatory days of penance should not be understood as limiting the occasions for Christian penance. The spirit of the season of Lent should be maintained throughout the weeks of Lent.
4. The obligation to observe penitential days of the Church is serious. Failure to observe individual days of penance is not necessarily considered serious. No one should be scrupulous in this regard. People should seek to do more rather than less, since fast and abstinence on the days prescribed should be considered a minimal response to the Lord's call to penance and conversion of life.
