For the next 105 days, she was carefully maintained on life-support systems until, at 32 weeks, a caesarean section delivered a 4 lb., 15 oz boy, normal and healthy. This was the second longest case of this: in 1989, a Vermont woman was kept on life support for 107 days prior to delivery. Isn't medical practice schizophrenic when it supports elective abortions?
