CATHOLIC POSITION ON HEALTH CARE REFORM

The National Conference of Catholic Bishops and the bishops of Louisiana support health care reform but categorically oppose the inclusion of abortion mandates in any proposal, therefore, you are urged to write to your two U. S. Senators and your Congressman asking them to support the Catholic position on health care reform. Below is a sample letter you may wish to use.

Dear Senator/Congressman _____:

As an active Catholic, I am writing to you about my concern that Congress will attempt to include abortion mandates as part of the health care bill which is about to be debated. I am vehemently opposed to abortion mandates and strongly urge you to vote against any bill which includes such mandates.

Many Catholics and non-Catholics alike support the concept of health care reform. When abortion mandates are included, millions - including myself - change from support to opposition. A recent poll confirms that 65% of Americans oppose taxpayer subsidized abortion coverage. Abortion mandates would force millions of employers, churches and individuals to subsidize abortions in violation of their consciences. And, for Catholics, abortion mandates would jeopardize the future of Catholic providers of health care.

I ask that you not only oppose any bill which includes abortion mandates but that you support language which will specifically exclude such mandates.
