





## Special Announcement

Dear sisters and brothers in Lord,

As you well know, the priest or priests in your parish work very hard for you. They have been ordained for service. As your Archbishop, I rely on these good men to proclaim the Gospel, administer the sacraments, and build communities in Christ. I praise them for their sacrifice. Today, I commend them to you and ask that you affirm them too, for they have dedicated their lives to you.

To stay abreast of changes in their lives, in their ministries, and in society, priests are required to spend some time each year in continuing education. Usually, several workshops are offered consecutively so that some priests always remain available for parish duties. This year will be different.

I am calling all priests to spend two days at a convocation devoted to the renewal of priestly identity. This gathering will give your priests an opportunity to meet at a local hotel for an intense seminar on what it means to be a priest today. I am confident that they will return to you refreshed and inspired.

Because of this convocation, there will be no priest at your parish on Tuesday and Wednesday, January 17-18, 1995. Due to the absence of your parish priests, the regularly scheduled weekday Masses on Tuesday evening and on Wednesday are to be cancelled. There is a small pool of non-parochial priests who are not attending the convocation. They will be available for emergencies. Your parish staff will know how to contact them.

I know you will understand the need for the absence of your clergy for two days. Be assured that any inconvenience you might suffer will be more than offset by the blessings which priests will receive from attending this convocation.

I ask that you join me in praying for all priests and for an increase in vocations to the priesthood. Pray especially for those attending the convocation that they may experience more profoundly the power of God's love working in them.
