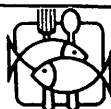
LENTEN MISSION

From Archbishop Schulte: (March 7, 1996)

This month, Congress is expected to begin hearings on H.R. 1833, the Partial-Birth Abortion Ban Act of 1995. Partial-Birth Abortion is the direct and brutal killing of a child who is mostly and already born alive....before baby can be delivered completely, the abortion practitioner spikes the partially-born child's head, sucks out the brain, thereby killing the infant. In actuality the practice is one-fifth abortion and four-fifths infanticide. To allow such a procedure is to confirm that our society can no longer protect life even outside the womb.

My purpose in alerting you to this bill is that President Clinton has threatened to veto the measure if it does not include a "health exception". Since the Roe v Wade decision, the Supreme Court has defined "health" in the context of abortion to include all forms of psychological, emotional or social "well-being." In a February 22 letter to President Clinton, Cardinal Bernard Law of Boston said such an exception would render the bill meaningless.... even prominent abortion practitioners have admitted that there are no true "health" reasons why any doctor would need to employ this procedure.

I urge each and every Catholic to write today to our Senators and Representatives asking them to vote in favor of H.R. 1833 without exceptions. I also urge you to write to President Clinton requesting that he reconsider the "health" exception.
