Why did the President veto the bill when a bi-partisan majority in both houses of Congress saw fit to approve it? Why did he veto the bill when 78% of women polled last February said "no" to Partial-Birth Abortions? Why did he veto the bill that was acceptable to 65% of Americans who describe themselves as pro-choice.

The President stated that he vetoed it because it did not contain a "health exclusion". But President Clinton knows full well that since Roe v. Wade the Supreme Court has held that "health" in the context of abortion includes all forms of psychological, emotional or social "well-being". To have included such an exception, the Congress understood, was to render the bill meaningless.

IN their strong and unprecedented letter of denunciation to President Clinton, the cardinals and the president of the Bishops' Conference said the veto "moves our nation one step further toward acceptance of infanticide. Combined with the two recent federal appeals court decisions seeking to legitimize assisted suicide, it sounds the alarm that public officials are moving our society ever more rapidly to embrace a culture of death".

I urge each and every one of you to do all that you can in the coming days and weeks to educate your families, your friends, and your neighbors to the heinous nature of the medical procedure known as Partial-Birth Abortion. And I urge you also to write without delay to our Senators and Representatives asking them to vote in favor of overriding President Clinton's veto of H.R. 1833.
