### GUIDE FOR ASSEMBLING YOUR FAMILY ALTAR

Building your family altar to prepare for the beginning of the third millennium is a project that the whole family can work on together. It should in fact reflect the cares, concerns, and needs of each family member. There are no hard or fast rules to follow. Your goal is to establish a center of worship in your home; a place where family members can comfortably communicate with God and spend time in His presence.

The material used to build your altar may be varied as your imagination and needs dictate. The basic framework may be any table or similar structure in your home. The covering for your altar may be a regular table cover used by the family, a bed sheet, blanket, or piece of cloth or guilt, or some other meaningful covering. A cover is not necessary, however, you decide what is pleasing to you and your family.

The center of the altar is an image of Christ or one of the Holy Family. What goes on the altar is up to your family's needs and interests. Items chosen are ones that represent who we are, our concerns, our hopes, etc. Some possibilities: pictures, toys, relics of saints of your choice, family documents, candles, the Bible, medals, or mementoes of family members.
