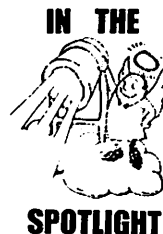
Special Announcement

— MISSIONARY COOPERATIVE APPEAL —

Next weekend at all the Masses we will have an appeal on behalf of the **Concolata Missionaries**. The Concolata Missionaries have missionary centers in Africa (Ethiopia, Kenya, Liberia, Libya, Mozambique, Somalia, South Africa, Tanzania, Uganda and Zaire) and in Asia (So. Korea) and in South America (Argentina, Brazil, Colombia, Ecuador and Venezuela).

The order announces the Good News of Jesus Christ in countries where He is little known. They promote and defend Human Values in the world. Depending where they work, they build and direct health centers, hospitals, schools and orphanages, churches, old folks homes as well as centers for the handicapped.

The appeal next week will be particularly for their Vicariate of San Vicente-Puerto Leguizamo in the Amazonic area of southern Colombia, covering 57,000 square miles. They are striving to organize the Christian communities of more than 600 small villages in the forest. There are no roads, poor health services and very little help from the government. The total population is 110,000 of which 37,000 are Catholic.

Their mission is to combine evangelization with human promotion; trying to prepare the Christian leaders, foster informal education, teach how to grow legal crops rather than the drug producing plants, make homes for orphans and they are working on a junior seminary for formation of local clergy.

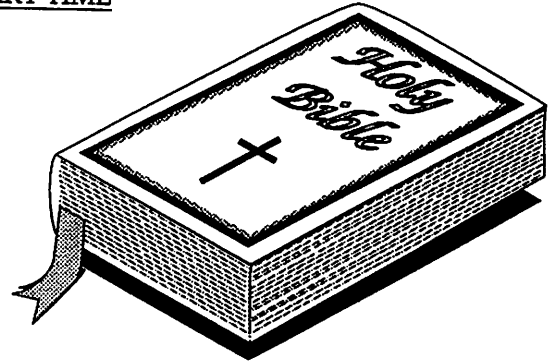


