FROM THE PASTORS DESK Saturday Vigil Masses

In the spring of 1997 Archbishop Schulte issued a policy for the Archdiocese concerning Saturday vigil masses. The Archbishop stated that this anticipated mass may not begin before 4:00 p.m. This policy does not apply to Christmas.


At the meeting in September and October, the East Jefferson Deanery, brought the matter up for discussion. It was resolved that the deanery would follow a single policy. Beginning in January, 1998, the deanery decided to have one vigil mass in each parish. In order to forestall any parish shopping, the deanery further decided to have this vigil mass at 4:00 p.m. This will require some parishes to drop a mass, and others to adjust their mass schedule. With this spirit of mutual cooperation, this policy will have less of a negative impact. The original introduction of vigil masses was to be for the fulfilling of a specific need. The multiplication of these masses for convenience is not in the spirit for which they were introduced. While all who attend both vigil masses in any parish may not be absorbed into one vigil mass, they certainly may be absorbed by the masses in the rest of the weekend schedule.

Therefore, it is the policy in the East Jefferson Deanery, beginning in January, 1998, only <u>one</u> vigil mass will be celebrated in each parish, and that mass will be celebrated at 4:00 p.m.
