A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Once again our parish property has been the subject of thoughtless vandalism. Recently the covers of trash cans were taken off and thrown around the property, and the concrete benches and wooden bleachers have been damaged by skaters. Also, the finish of the patterned concrete walkway through our beautiful Courtyard of Saints was deeply marred, apparently by the rubber tracks of skates and a bicycle. To repair the damage to this area it was necessary to totally remove and replace the sealed finish of this surface. The financial cost to our parish to repair this walkway is \$1,800.00. More importantly, however, is the cost to our parish community in the lack of respect for our property. Each of us, as the community of St. Angela, is responsible for maintaining our property as a place of worship, education, and serving the needs of our parish. If the occasion presents itself that you observe someone doing damage to our parish property, please get involved by asking the name of the person. We can then report the incident to the Sheriff's Office.






<u>Registration and Open House</u> <u>for the Religion Classes</u> will be in September. Watch bulletin for more details to come.

Reminder: Any new student will need to bring a copy of their Baptism certificate to register for Religious Education Classes.


Reminder: Sacramental preparation requires that the children attend religious instruction regularly for two consecutive years prior to receiving a sacrament.

Baptism Preparation
