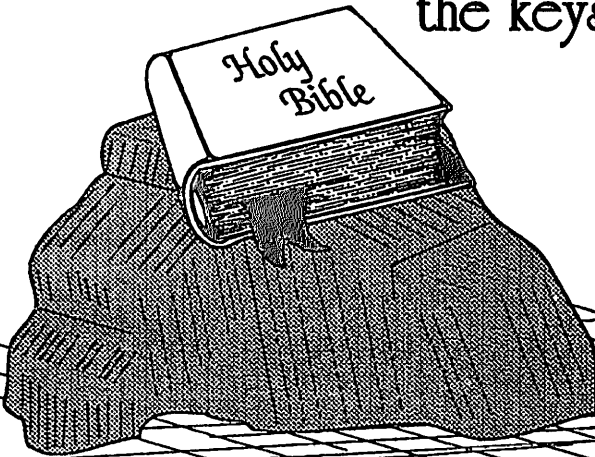

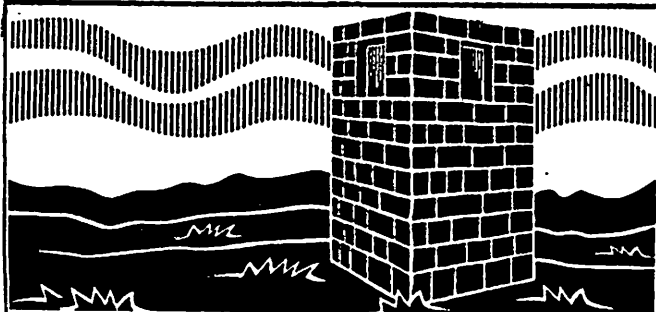

A Respect Life Sunday Message from Archbishop Schulte:

"As we approach the great Jubilee of the Year 2000, the anniversary of the Lord's birth, there is much for which we can be thankful in the continuing battle for life. In our own Archdiocese, there is a public awareness campaign encouraging women facing crisis pregnancies to choose life; the national abortion rate has been on a steady decrease for the last three years; there is less non-marital teen pregnancy, and more teens are choosing chastity.

How then do we enter the Twenty-first Century as a people of life? We must act as though a Culture of Life depends upon each one of us. I would like to quote from the Bishops' 1998 statement, "Living the Gospel of Life."

"We are now witnessing the gradual restructuring of American culture. . . where moral questions are submerged by a river of goods and services. . . No one can rightfully claim to share fully and practically the Catholic faith and yet act publicly in a way contrary to that faith. . . . Secularly society will allow believers to have whatever moral convictions they please – as long as they keep them on the private preserves of their consciences, in their homes and churches, and out of the public arena. Democracy is not a substitute for morality, nor a panacea for immorality. Its value stands – or falls – with the values which it embodies and promotes. . ."

I urge you, my brothers and sisters in the Lord, to do everything in your power – through prayer and witness – to develop the Culture of Life in your hearts, your homes and your community. The Culture of Life will overshadow the Culture of Death as we give witness to God's abundant love and mercy in our own lives."
