My dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord,

I am bringing to your attention an urgent need that affects Catholics as well as non-Catholics alike in our community. It is the necessary maintenance and endowment for our venerable Cathedral Basilica of St. Louis King of France.

St. Louis Cathedral Basilica is a focal point in the life of the Church in and of New Orleans and indeed of our entire community. It is not only the mother church, but it is also the symbol of our city and is the oldest cathedral in our nation. A community-wide feasibility study as well as several Archdiocesan advisory bodies have convinced me that I must appeal to the people of the archdiocese as well as the civic community to meet the needs of this spiritual and civic treasure.

The Archdiocesan Priests Council has endorsed two archdiocesan collections for the Cathedral. The first will be the weekend of May 27-28, 2000, and the second will be next year at the same time. The Cathedral Parish itself will conduct a more intensive fundraising effort among its own parishioners. Meanwhile, during the next several weeks, I will be promoting our cause throughout the entire metropolitan area.

You will be hearing more about this campaign and how you can help — through your parish bulletins, your pastors, and the local media. The minimum goal of the campaign has been set at \$2.5 million, and will only be used to meet the immediate needs of preservation and future endowment so that we may be able to limit future campaigns for this purpose. There is no intention for changes to be made to the interior or exterior of this magnificent Cathedral.

St. Louis Cathedral Basilica serves our archdiocese in countless ways and has done so over the centuries. While it is important to secure the funds during this campaign, it is even more important that all of us have a sense of ownership of our venerable Cathedral.

We've had a lot of work going on "behind closed doors!!! But, now that school is closed, you can see evidence of our major renovation project.

Since we vacated Church March 15th, insulation and fitting work has been underway above the church ceiling and below the floors of school. The pews and kneelers are being removed in stages, refinished, and reinstalled in Church. While the pews are removed, the concrete floor is cleaned and leveled, and the new vinyl tile surface is being installed under the pews.

Thanks to some volunteers from SAMA, the carpet has been removed from Church. Some of our young people, in earning service hours, are cleaning the brass transit strips that will go between the carpet and the new vinyl tile surface.

Demolition and removal of the old air conditioning and heating equipment began the afternoon of the final day of school. The interior chemical cleaning of the water pipes has been completed, and some of the new equipment has arrived.

If you are around during the weekdays you can see a lot of activity. But, for those who aren't – and all the others - we will be taking advantage of our bulletin as an information source to keep you updated on the progress of these major improvements to our Church and school facilities.




