FROM THE PASTOR: I want to share with you the following urgent appeal that I received early this morning from Bethlehem. As you will recall, we have been able, through your generous contributions, to assist The Antonian Society in the past. While we will not have a special collection for this appeal, if you would consider making a specific contribution to assist this need, I ask that you place it in an envelope in the Sunday collection, or bring it to the rectory, and we will make certain that it is sent to our brothers in Christ who reside in Bethlehem.

6 August 2001

Dear Rev. Crosby,
I am addressing you on behalf of the Antonian
Charitable Society, a pioneer in the charitable and benevolent field, appealing to your sense of good will and true sympathy for your Christian brethren in the Holy Land.

The Antonian Society, established in Bethlehem in 1913 to serve the needs of the poor and the destitute in the community, has throughout several generations managed to fulfill its basic mission by providing human care and financial support. This Institution is running a Home for the Aged, which houses now 45 residents, mostly social cases with limited or hardly any outside support. It is also running a Nursery for the care of children whose mothers are compelled to work in order to help in the sustenance of their families.

help in the systemance of their families.

In addition to the maintenance of a Home for the Aged, and a Day-Care Center for the Children, the Antonian Society has until recently consistently provided aid to needy families by covering medical cost, food expenses, schooling tuition and cash donations to orphans and widows. The Society has depended mostly on support from benevolent institutions and local aid. But lately with the outburst of the Intifada, the desperate economic situation prevailing throughout the land, the siege and isolation of Bethlehem, the cessation of the inflow of tourism, the crisis of unemployment, the absence of governmental social security and welfare programs, the Society has run out of funds and is consequently unable to offer aid to hundreds of Bethlehemite families who are suffering from dire need and even from the lack of

basic items for their subsistence.

We are constantly receiving appeals for help. It pains us to be unable to respond to these appeals and meet their immediate needs. We are also at our wit's end being faced with the essential expenses needed to provide for the Home-for-the-Aged, and

which we cannot cope with.

A serious calamity affecting the presence and the morale of the Christians in the Bethlehem area is the emigration of the young and even of whole families. Young people without work for more than ten months are suffering from inustration and demoralization and are no longer able to withstand the daily challenges. This disastrous aspect resulting from the deplorable economic situation, the lack of security, the intolerable restrictions of the Occupation, the bombardment and demolition of houses, and other factors, is luring them towards more segme and stable and other factors, is luring them towards more secure and stable living conditions, and particularly towards the United States. This is a dangerous phenomenon which entails the dwindling of the number of Christians in the Holy Land.

In view of this desperate situation, we hereby address ourselves to you, to people of good will, earnestly calling upon your humanitarian sense and brotherly love praying for support in these extremely difficult times, for the relief of the suffering community in Bethlehem, thus helping its people to remain

steadfast in their native country.
