

Above all, we must pray.



Advent, which comes from the Latin word for "arrival" or "coming," is a period of preparation for the birth of our Lord. Advent begins four Sundays before Christmas and is the start of the Christmas season, which lasts through the Baptism of Our Lord. The first

Sunday of Advent also marks the beginning of the liturgical year, the Church's "New Year's Day," at which time we change the cycle of readings we are using at Mass.

Advent is a time of joyous anticipation, but also of penance and preparation for the great Christmas feast. The liturgical color of the season is purple, a sign of penance, which is also used during Lent. The Church discourages excessive ornamentation, boisterous music and even weddings during Advent, in order to foster a sense of quiet hope.

RETIREMENT FUND FOR RELIGIOUS

The appeal this weekend marks a key fund-raising effort to raise money for retired religious in the U.S. who for years worked with little or no salary and/or retirement benefits. "Promise, Commitment, Impact" is the theme for the 2002 Retirement Fund for Religious Collection.

This once-a-year appeal is made in parishes nationwide to offset \$6.4 billion underfunding of retirement for brothers, sisters and priests in U.S. religious orders. This year's collection is the fifteenth appeal since the Retirement Fund for Religious was inaugurated in 1988.

There are few Catholics who have not benefitted from Catholic schools, hospitals, and/or other institutions staffed and supported by our nation's religious. Since the campaign's start over \$373 million has been distributed and more than 96 percent of the collection has been distributed among 496 religious communities.

Much of the credit for great works of the church in the United States goes to those men and women religious who built up schools and hospitals for service to the needs of others.






