### Dear Parishioners.

Memories of Pope John Paul II will linger in our hearts for many years to come. Reflections on his singular commitment to Christ and the Church will inspire us for the rest of our lives. The wisdom of his teachings will live on in our Church for a very long time. He has been an exemplary leader. He is truly a Doctor of the Church, for his authoritative, deep and challenging teaching. We continue at our Masses this weekend to pray to God in thanksgiving for all that Pope John Paul II has done for our Church and we pray "in joyful hope" that the gift of everlasting life with Christ and peace in the reign of heaven will now be his well-merited reward.

Our hopes and our prayers must now begin to turn to the selection of his successor, the next Pope who will lead our Church, serving as the very Vicar of Christ. Brownie Troop #72 members and their parents, under the leadership of Teresa Miller, have added new plantings to the side of the Msgr. Kern Center and have cleaned the garden area in front of the Center, even steam-cleaning the exterior and the sidewalk. Again, they donated time and materials. It really looks like Spring around our buildings! THANKS to these generous parishioners for their care and their generosity.

The second issue of "Eucharist: Jesus With Us" is now available in church, on the tables with the hymnals. This series is being offered to you during this "Year of the Eucharist." Please pick up a copy as you leave church this weekend, if you missed them last weekend.

This was unexpected: There are two compressors that cool the church and school and, six weeks ago, one of them broke. Very fortunately, it was still under the extended warranty that was purchased when the unit was installed just three years ago. Our Business Manager, Jackie Appleton met with representatives from the Archdiocesan Building Office, the contractor, the manufacturer of the unit, the mechanical engineer and Entergy to try to determine why the unit failed so soon. That meeting proved inconclusive. We are waiting for the new compressor to arrive, which should be within two weeks. While it was under warranty, we will still have to pay about \$6,000.00 for labor and some parts not included in the warranty coverage. Of course, this rather substantial expenditure was unexpected and shows again the need for all of our parishioners to be conscientious in your weekly financial support of your parish!





### Dear Parishioners,

Each year, we are given the special opportunity to nominate to the Archbishop names of candidates to receive the Medallion of the Order of St. Louis, which is a recognition given by the Archbishop to those who have contributed outstanding service to their parishes. Next Sunday, May 1, Archbishop Alfred Hughes will bestow the Medallion of the Order of St. Louis on people from parishes of the Archdiocese. I am happy to share with you that, this year, we have selected Lola Lee Sinnott and Larry McNamara to receive the medallion from the Archbishop for outstanding service to our parish.







### Dear Parishioners,

I ask you to continue to keep Fr. Willie Meridier in your prayers as he continues to face with courage his illness. Father and I had been talking about the possibility of having some sort of appreciation gathering for him, but he feels that his condition prohibits this. So, I hope that you will take just a few moments to send him a greeting by mail and to let him know how much he means to us here at St. Angela for his many years of priestly ministry to our parish. He has told me that he takes the time to read each note he receives and that your words of support and assurance of prayers means a great deal to him at this time on his journey of life and faith. Send him a card or a letter:

Because Father Meridier will no longer be able to assist us with weekend Masses and the Sacrament of Penance, I asked the Pastoral Council to determine a procedure to review and assess our weekend Mass schedule and to offer me a proposal about what direction we should take at this time. At their meeting earlier this month, the Pastoral Council spent the substantial part of their meeting in a lively, careful and thoughtful discussion about our current staffing, our parish needs, the quality of each Sunday liturgy and our financial resources. By the end of the meeting, the Council offered a proposal which I have accepted.

We will not seek to find another priest to take Fr. Meridier's place. Thus, respecting the number of priests we now have, we will initiate a new Mass schedule on the first weekend of June, June 4-5. This will be our new weekend schedule: Saturday: Sacrament of Penance, 3:00-3:45 p.m.; anticipated Mass of Sunday at 4:00 p.m.

Sunday: Masses at 8:00 a.m., 9:30 a.m., 11:00 a.m. and 12:30 p.m.

Please note TWO changes: Beginning in June, we will no longer offer the Mass on Sunday evening and, beginning that same weekend, the final morning Mass will begin at 12:30 p.m. The reason for dropping one Mass is simple: we now have one less priest assisting with weekend liturgies. The reasons this particular Mass was selected for change: it has the least consistent regular attendance; it is very difficult to get Readers, Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion and Altar Servers for this Mass; there are not sufficient regular Ushers who serve at this Mass; we will save some money by dropping one Mass, since our cantors and organists are salaried ministers; we will economize by not having to restart the heating/AC system in the afternoon for that one Mass. The reasons for changing the starting time of the last morning Mass from 12:15 to 12:30: it is Archdiocesan policy that Masses be scheduled not less than ninety minutes apart in starting times; because any extra ritual, longer homily or even longer readings at the 11:00 a.m. creates great problems in the parking lot and with the flow of traffic (and has often caused that Mass to begin later than 12:15 p.m. anyway), this slightly later starting time is preferable.

At this time, we will NOT make any adjustments to the weekday morning Mass schedule, or the Saturday morning Mass.

Following another lengthy discussion at our April Staff Meeting, we have also decided to make an adjustment with our Holy Day schedule. We had added the 6:00 p.m. Mass on holy days on an experimental basis: we will make that change permanent. We will, however, discontinue the 12 Noon Mass on holy days, since the attendance was not very high. We will, instead, have a Mass on holy days that fall on school days at 10:00 a.m. and bring all of the school children to this Mass.

Changing Mass schedules is about my least favorite thing to do, since it is impossible to come up with a plan that will satisfy all. So, I ask your understanding of this carefully thought out proposal from our Pastoral Council and your support of what needed to be done in modifying the schedule. I thank the Council members for their conscientious work on this and am grateful to them for this and all the great consultative insight they share with me and our Pastoral Team in serving you.

#### Dear Parishioners.

This is important, so please note and, if you can, even share the word with others: When there is a death in your family, Fr. Luis and I ask that you call us at the rectory as quickly as possible. It is important to us to minister to your family at such a critical time. To face death with courage takes faith and faith is expressed and nourished by prayer. At the time of death, Fr. Luis and I want to be present to you and to pray with you for your deceased loved one. We know that the prayer of faith will assist you and carry you through such a difficult moment.

It is also very important that families contact us before contacting a funeral home to begin to make arrangements there for the visitation and funeral liturgy. As you know, Fr. Luis is also the Director of Vocations for the Archdiocese. He does go to that office every day to fulfill his responsibilities there and often must set appointments and meetings well in advance. Of course, he and I both have commitments here in the parish as well: appointments and meetings that sometimes cannot be readily rescheduled. You need to know when we might be available for the funeral services before you begin to discuss this with the funeral director. Sometimes, quite honestly, we may need to work together to find the time that is best for the funeral for the family's convenience and our availability. Nonetheless, as your parish priests, we want to be with you in prayer at such an important time. Too many funeral homes currently try to foist a time on a family that fits the funeral home's schedule and is not sensitive to the schedule of your parish priest

It is also important for you to contact us because we do want to spend some time with you preparing the funeral liturgy. If you remember, last year I mailed to each parish household a copy of the funeral liturgy planning guide that we use here in our parish, and we want to set up a time to meet with the family to discuss the many options of the funeral liturgy. The rituals of the Vigil Service (if there is to be a night-time visitation) and the prayers of the Funeral Liturgy (either with Mass or outside of Mass) provide many options for ministers, Scripture readings and prayers and, again, we want to take the time to speak with you and prepare the liturgy well. The well-prepared Funeral Liturgy can be a lovely tribute to the deceased loved one and a great consolation and source of hope to those who grieve.

I know that, especially in the early evenings and on weekends, we are busy about other activities and we have the taped message on the parish telephone line. Please do not hesitate, though, to leave us a message. Fr. Luis and I make every effort to check the tape as quickly and as often as we can, and we will return calls as expediently as possible. I appreciate your cooperation with us as Fr. Luis, our deacons and I seek to serve you well through our ordained ministry.

#### \*\*\*\*\*\*

The Spring Soiree was a success. I will have a more complete financial report to share with you in the next bulletin, but it looks like we did make enough profit to install the stage draperies and also to do at least some of the work in upgrading the sound system.

I thank all of those who pulled together in this effort: the members of the Soiree Planning Committee, who spent many hours in careful and thorough preparations, all those who came Friday and Saturday to help decorate (it was wonderful seeing SALA, SAMA and Co-Op members all working together!), those who staffed the raffle and auction tables, and all of you who purchased tickets and participated in the party. I really get a thrill out of seeing a parish come together in this way, for it reflects the unity of our faith, our joy in service and our care for one another, this time all with a party to boot!



#### Dear Parishioners,

The Spring Soiree was a wonderfully enjoyable evening and all in attendance had positive comments to share. I hope you have heard these words and, if you were not part of this year's Soiree, will consider joining us next year when Soiree time rolls around again.

There were a total of 237 tickets sold, most in advance, some at the door and a number were purchased by groups for an extra chance or two at the big raffle. Live and Silent Auction items sales totaled \$15,972.00 and the 50/50 raffle netted \$555.00. Taking out expenses (primarily food and beverage costs and the DJ), our profit this year was \$20,245.00. We will be able now to install draperies on the stage. There will be black drapes hung along the rear wall and the two sides of the stage and blue drapes (matching the ones on the windows) along the front. During the Summer, our Building and Grounds Committee will refinish the entire stage, including the doors on the front of the stage where we have some below-stage storage areas. We anticipate that this work will be completed by the end of July, all in time for our next school year and the start-up of all our Fall parish meetings and activities.

We are still reviewing bids for the sound system to determine what part of that project we might be able to undertake at this time. We may have to do this up-grade either in stages or perhaps even wait until after the next Soiree. I will, of course, let you know what we are able to do with remaining Soiree Funds.

I would like, on your behalf, to offer a special word of thanks and congratulations to the Soiree Planning Committee for their generous sharing of time and talents and the success of the evening. Committee member are: Robert Brown, Muriel Carriere, Colette Cisco, Kay Hymel, and Mary "Tee" Toups, all under the able leadership of our school Principal, Colleen Remont. Decorations for the evening were coordinated by Mac and Kathy Cantrell.

Again, thanks to all those who helped in any way and those who participated in the evening. A number of parishioners, because of other commitments, were not able to be at the Soiree but purchased tickets and were still part of the \$10,000 drawing; others made a donation and gave the parish their tickets, allowing us to pass them on to parishioners who otherwise would not have been financially able to come to the Soiree. I think these are very fine examples of supporting this parish activity, and I thank these folks for their generosity in support and in sharing. Add to this the energy of the Co-Op, SALA and SAMA members who came and helped set up and decorate and this really was a total parish effort. Thanks to all!

A School Board member is present who is able to relay information about our school as well. We will continue these through October.

#### Dear Parishioners.

As we continue in this "Year of the Eucharist," there are two new offerings that I would like to tell you about that I believe will enhance your understanding and appreciation of this Sacrament of Christ's living presence among us.

The first is this: the newest installment of the monthly newsletter, "Eucharist: Jesus with Us," is now available in church. Please pick up a copy as you leave church this weekend and take it home with you to read. This is the fourth in the series that we will continue to provide for you for the remainder of this "Year of the Eucharist." This is very easy and quick reading; it take only about ten minutes to read the entire issue, but provides much rich food for thought and continuing reflection. I have been saving all of them in one folder and went back this week to read the first four together. I have found that the author, Fr. Thomas Richstatter, is moving us ever more deeply into the mystery of the Eucharist and into a fuller understanding of the Mass in this well-written series.

The second offering: we begin in our parish this week a special three-part series that will focus on the encyclical of Pope John Paul II on the Eucharist, Eucharistia de Ecclesia, or On the Eucharist and Its Relationship to the Church, written by Pope John Paul II in April, 2003. We will hold these study sessions in the parish Conference Room on three Monday evenings: June 13, June 27 and July 11, each night from 7:00-8:30 p.m.

Originally, I had offered to lead these sessions, but that has changed just a bit. I will conduct the first session and, in that one, I will share with you an overview of the nature and purpose of an encyclical and also discuss with you some other encyclicals and documents that helped shaped John Paul's thoughts and teachings in this letter. I will also point out some strong themes in the encyclical for you to be aware of as you begin to read and study it more deeply. Then, Deacon Ron Guidry, Director of the Office of Worship of the Archdiocese, will take over for the next two sessions and lead you through a study and discussion of this letter in even more depth.

If you would like to participate in this series, please go to the internet (or have your grandchild show you how to!); go to the site "papalencyclicals.net" and you can print out the entire encyclical. Now, let me be honest, this is not the easiest reading you'll ever come across, so we will also make available to those participating a translation in a simplified version from a national publishing company.

There will be one Parish Information Gathering this week: on Tuesday, June 14 at 7:00 p.m. The purpose of these gatherings is to share with you information about the life of our parish, especially our currents Mission Statement and goals and some financial information as well. We have been receiving very positive feedback from those who have already participated in these sessions, so I urge all of you to make the time in your schedule to join us for one of them. Please telephone the rectory to register for an up-coming session.

My gosh you really do notice when we're not around, don't you? Someone asked me how I enjoyed my vacation last weekend: well, I wasn't on vacation! I am a member (as is Fr. Luis) of the Order of the Holy Sepulchre of Jerusalem, which is an organization that raises money for the Christians and for the shrines in the Holy Land. I currently serve as Ecclesiastical Master of Ceremonies for the organization and I was at the annual meeting last weekend, coordinating and serving as mc at the liturgies. Next weekend (June 18-19) I will be away again, going to Wilmette, IL for the 50th Anniversary of Profession celebration of a Sister I worked with while I was pastor of St. Francis of Assisi Church. I will be away from June 16-20, stopping to visit with a classmate in Crawfordsville, IN on the way. I'll let you know about our real vacations in next week's bulletin!

#### Dear Parishioners,

On Monday evening, beginning at 7:00 p.m., our parish Adult Faith Formation Committee will host the second in the three-part series on Pope John Paul II's encyclical letter, "The Eucharist and Its Relationship to the Church." for this, and again for the final session on July 11, we welcome to our parish Deacon Ron Guidry, Director of the Office of Worship of the Archdiocese. I know you will learn much from his presentation and so, on behalf of the Adult Faith Formation Committee, I invite and urge you to attend. The session will be in the Parish Conference Room.

This past Easter we were privileged to have four adults become new members of our Catholic Church: one sharing in the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist at the Easter Vigil and three being received into the Full Communion of the Catholic Church through the profession of faith and the sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist on Easter Sunday.

We will begin again, at the end of the Summer, with our RCIA process – the process through which adults are prepared for these sacraments when they have either not been baptized before or seek to come into our Church from other Christian denominations.

If you are not Catholic but are interested in learning more about the Catholic Church, if you think your faith journey is leading you into our Church, now is the time for you to come forward so that we may speak individually with you and share with you more detail about the process before it begins in the Fall. 


