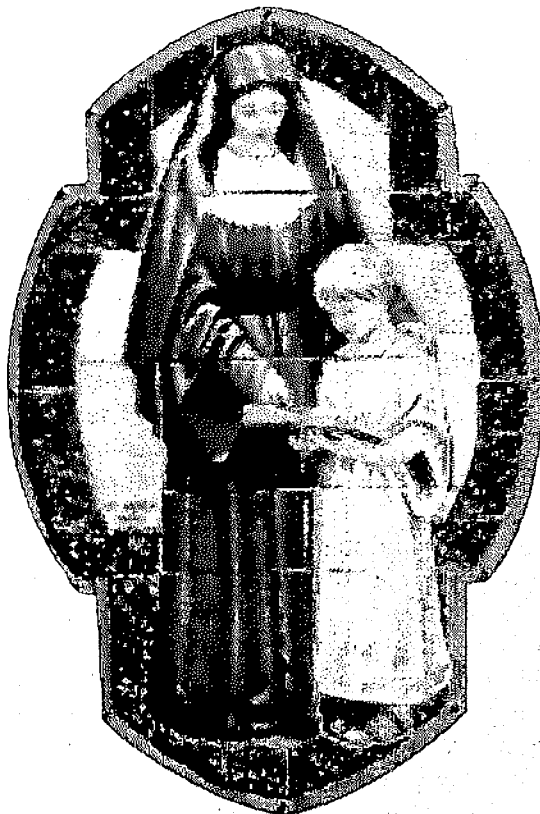

This is a continuation from last week on Faith Formation.

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults- RCIA is to guide interested non-Catholics through a process of initiation into the faith. This is for individuals who have never been baptized in the Christian faith; or individuals who many have been baptized in another Christian denomination but wish to become members of the Catholic Church; or individuals who have been baptized in the Catholic Church but have not received all the Sacraments of Initiation (Communion and/or Confirmation). For this ministry we need adult sponsors who will attend weekly classes with the candidates, some to serve as hospitality ministers (prepare room for session), some to serve as leaders for breaking open the word. The sponsors would need one or two training sessions and the leaders for breaking open the word would need one training session and one observation session. Scott Corrente is the liaison for this ministry and can be contacted at 835-0324.

Adult Faith Formation consists of a group of interested adults who meet 3-4 times a year to plan religious activities that cover a 5 year period. This is a planning, dreaming group of adults. No training is necessary, just come and dream and plan with us. Sr. Paula is the liaison for this committee and can be reached at 837-9347.

FAMILIA is a prayer and study group for mothers of young children. The program is based on the Encyclicals of Pope John Paul II. This organization offers mothers the opportunity to strengthen their families and apply their faith with focused information and practical tools that can be implemented in daily life. It assists parents in developing a strong family structure. It is a way to develop a strong faith family and to become a strong faith support group. It promotes harmony among all family members, especially between husband and wife. It fosters an awareness of the need for Christ and the Church in daily family life. Each group that forms has children of diverse ages and the mothers have different years of the experience of marriage. Members benefit from the Word of God, encyclicals of Pope John Paul II and the wisdom of others. This group meets twice a month, September through May, at the convenience of the members. The sessions are held every Tuesday from 9:15-10:45 a.m. beginning September 16 through November 18 and again January 13 through April 30. 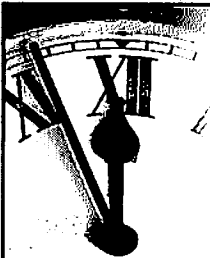

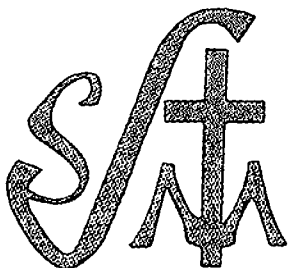

Family Life Apostolate (FLA) is a ministry within our parish that serves, encourages and celebrates all families in our homes and church community. It is the blending of our families that enables us to grow and be renewed in our faith community. FLA is involved in various ministries. We WELCOME new parishioners with a reception, personal notes, and invitations to parish functions. Support is offered to the families of the BEREAVED with personal notes, Mass cards, and prayers. Coffee and pastries are provided in the conference room for families and friends during the visitation when held in church. FLA offers PRAYER support through our prayer line via e-mail. There are presently 197 parishioners who receive the intentions that are sent to the prayer line on a regular basis. There is a prayer request book located in the back of church and all these intentions are included in the Prayers of the Faithful at our weekend Masses. FLA's HOSPITALITY includes parish-wide Potluck dinners, a Married Couples Dinner, Wine and Cheese for Married Couples, Missions Reception, Family Day Masses, Poster and Essay Contests, and other family activities as they develop. It would be a blessing to have your gifts and talents as FLA reaches out to our parish family. Whether you are male or female, single, married, divorced or widowed, you are part of God's family. Please join us as a member. We have Membership meetings twice a year and Chair meetings every other month. We value your time and talents. FLA is currently trying to expand our ministries to serve families with young children and the elderly.

St. Angela Ladies Auxiliary is an organization made up of ladies from St. Angela Merici Parish who unite all members in service to our parish and promote religious and social interests of the members. They also work and promote various activities in the parish such as the Fair in the fall, the Spring Soiree, and Scripture Safari in the summer. Church activities include housekeeping, flower memorials, and cleaning linens for the church. The ladies meet on the first Tuesday of the month, September through May, in the Monsignor Kern Center at 7 p.m. Every meeting includes socializing and refreshments. As an example of our socializing, this past we enjoyed activities such as Bonco, Family Feud Game, and a Street Costume Game for the Halloween Party. Trips included a Zephyr's baseball game, a trip to St. Joseph's Plantation in Vacherie, and a trip to the D-Day Museum.

Guest speakers are also invited to the meetings. During Advent a morning of prayer is conducted for the parish with a guest speaker. The Liturgy Committee of SALA leads the rosary daily before the 8:30 a.m. Mass, and selects a member once a month to receive the Vocations Cross at Mass and to pray for vocations for one week.

This is a small example of SALA's work and activities. SALA invites all ladies of the Parish to join them.

Dear Parishioners,

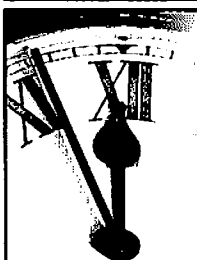

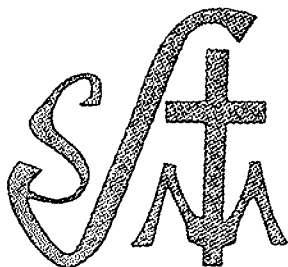

Colleen gets to celebrate part of her birthday with our school faculty, who, along with Colleen, will be at their faculty meetings in preparation for the new school year. Yes, school is almost ready to begin again!

I want to thank our maintenance men, Mike Volpi and Alberto Corrales, along with Nathaniel Fields who worked with them this Summer, for their good work in preparing the buildings for the new school term. Special thanks to the men and women of the parish who came in earlier this Summer to paint the classrooms. 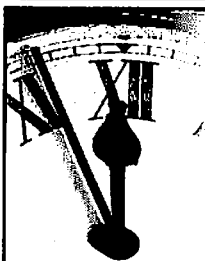

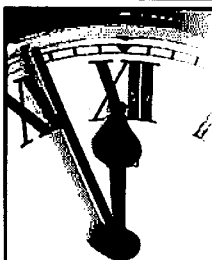

Dear Parishioners,

Throughout the Summer, we have been sharing with you in the bulletin information about our many parish organizations and ministries, all in preparation for our Parish Ministries Fair **next weekend**, August 23-24. I hope that you have not only been reading this information, but also reflecting on it and discerning if you are being called to a new level of participation in parish life and ministries.

If you have questions about an organization or ministry, those already active will be at the Fair, ready to answer your questions.

If you have concerns about the commitment of skills or time, those already active will have information about each ministry/organization that will include, as necessary, schedules of activities/meetings.

If you are ready to sign up for a ministry or organization, those at the tables will be ready and anxious to assist you!

We have been highlighting in these short summaries the particular needs of some of our organizations and ministries. There are obvious places we need you!

"We are called," we regularly sing in one of our Mass hymns. We are a people called to build and live the reign of Christ through our active participation in the life of the Church, best lived here in and with your parish family. Respond to the call. We are all on journeys of faith, journeys that are sometimes easy, even enjoyable, journeys that are sometimes challenging and difficult. 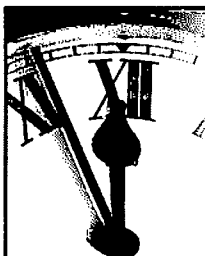

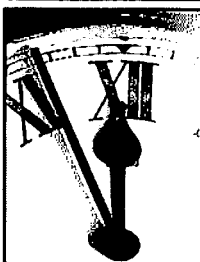

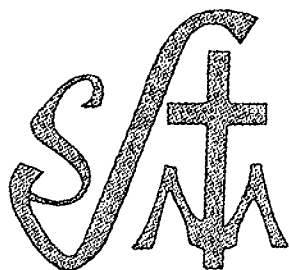

Dear Parishioners,

Because of the Labor Day holiday, we had to get this issue of the bulletin to the printer very early, way before we know what Gustav bring us. With Hanna right behind, let us continue to pray through Our Lady of Prompt Succor, for safety during this more-active hurricane season.

Let me also take this opportunity to remind you of the procedure prepared by our Pastoral Staff and approved by our Pastoral Council

When an evacuation is called for by local civic authorities, whether this is a recommended, voluntary or mandatory evacuation scheduled parish activities, including liturgical services, will be cancelled immediately. The Blessed Sacrament and parish sacramental records will be secured according to archdiocesan policy, parish facilities will be secured and all parish staff, including clergy, will follow the evacuation order and vacate the parish campus. All parishioners should similarly follow the evacuation order. Insurance regulations prohibit us from offering parish facilities as an evacuation shelter.

Our intent here is always to act on the side of caution!

In several very important ways, our Parish Ministries Fair was a grand success. The chairpersons of the Fair (David Barbier, Diane Kratochvil and Rob Whitaker) threw themselves into the organization and coordination of the day with an enthusiasm that I found contagious. Every parish organization invited to participate was present with folks to staff their booths, ready to share information and sign up new members. Lots of hands helped with the set-up, serving refreshments and clean-up after the Fair, as the Center had to be prepared for the Youth Group meeting that night. In spite of the inclement weather, parishioners came over to the Center after every

The very best news of the Fair: several new families registered as parishioners, new people were added to our parish Prayer Line and altogether, 113 people signed up to participate in a ministry or organization.

When we were preparing for the Ministries Fair, I asked each parish ministry/organization to be very clear about specific needs, and I is where our Fair at times was not as successful as we had anticipated. I will say a bit more about that in the bulletin either next week or the following (depending on when hurricanes begin to leave us alone!!!) and how we anticipate making up for a few gaps in recruitment.

Re-delegation workshops for our parish's extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion continue this week, with several sessions scheduled. I remind all those currently serving that I would like you to sign up on the form in the sacristy, indicating which session you plan to attend so that proper arrangements can be prepared for each session.

The Archdiocese has asked that we participate in a voter registration drive and we will do that THIS weekend. If you qualify as a voter and have not yet registered, registration forms are on a table next to the table where the gifts are placed before Mass. Fill in a form, drop it in the box provided and we will send it for you to the Registrar of Voters.

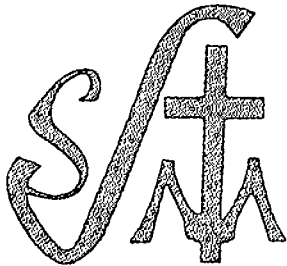

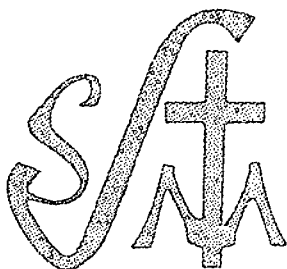

Dear Parishioners,

Today we observe, with parishes throughout the United States, Catechetical Sunday. Volunteer to work a booth, come and meet other parishioners, come and bring your whole family and enjoy the weekend's activities. Spend LOTS of money and know that it goes to a good cause: the Catholic formation of our young people through the outstanding education and environment provided them in our school.

For those of you who customarily bake sweets for the Fair: cake mixes, etc. are available for you in the former baptistery after the Masses this weekend.

Raffle tickets will be available in the back of Church this weekend. Please take a packet to show your support.

Dear Parishioners,

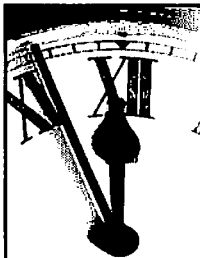
