



PENITENTIAL DISCIPLINES OF LENT

"The Christian faithful, during Lent, are clearly conscious of the need to turn the mind towards those realities which really count, which require Gospel commitment and integrity of life which, through self denial of those things which are superfluous, are translated into good works and solidarity with the poor and needy" (Directory on Popular Piety and the Liturgy, #125).

In addition to choosing their own penitential practices, Catholics are also asked to observe the practices of fast and abstinence during the 40 days of Lent. The Lenten Fast and Abstinence Regulations are as follows:

- 1. Everyone from 14 years or older is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent.
- 2. Everyone 18 years of age and under 59 years of age is bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. (The obligation of fasting ceases with the celebration of one's 59th birthday.)
- 3. Fasting on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday means eating only one full, meatless meal. Two other smaller, meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength , may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted on these two days, but liquids, including milk and fruit juices, are allowed. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige.
- 4. Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these prescribed minimal penitential practices.

Dear Parishioners,

Welcome to the season of Lent! I have been anticipating this Lent in a special way this year, and I am truly looking forward to the graces that God wants to give us individually and as a parish. I came across something recently that truly inspired me to truly respond to God in the Lenten season, and I want to share it with you.

On Sunday, February 12, my brother, Jean, talked to me about the "Nineveh 90", a 90 day challenge to pray and fast before the 100th anniversary of the first vision at Fatima on May 13, 2017. The Blessed Mother appeared to three children in Fatima, Portugal – once a month - from May 13, 1917 to October 13, 1917. She gave messages about the vital importance of conversion to Jesus Christ, encouraging the Church to pray for the conversion of souls, including our own. These apparitions and messages have been approved by the Church.

As the 100^{th} anniversary of the Fatima apparitions approaches, the Church is reflecting on how we are living out the message of Fatima. With the Nineveh 90, the Church comes together in community with a common focus – to evaluate how we are doing with personal conversion and prayer for the conversion of others. Prayers, fasting, mortification are all emphasized.

It is called the "Nineveh" 90 because Jonah was sent by God to preach to the city of Nineveh, calling the people of Nineveh to conversion. The people of Nineveh responded faithfully. In seeking Christ to convert our own souls and the souls of others, we are responding like the people of Nineveh and praying that the world will do the same.

You may ask, "why are you telling us about a program that already started?" Well, I learned about it a day before it began. But I'm sharing the Nineveh 90 because even though it already began, the 90 days from February 13th to May 13th cover the season of Lent, and the mission of the Lenten season and the Nineveh 90 are the same.

There is a website that informs and directs those that are interested in the "Nineveh 90" called Nineveh90.com. It is run by Fr. Richard M. Heilman, a priest from the Diocese of Madison, Wisconsin. From what I have seen on the website, it offers prayer challenges, instruction on building virtue, ideas for personal change and powerful community support.

There are many resources to engage God in the season of Lent, and this is a strong one. Please engage God in Lent! He is refining our souls and expanding our capacity to love Him and each other. Know that He loves you and wants the best for you.

Fr. Patrick and I pray for you daily. Pray for your priests and your pastoral staff.

SECOND ANNUAL FAMILY ST. JOSEPH'S ALTAR

One of the most important customs of the St. Joseph altar is the Tupa-Tupa, or "Knock Knock" ceremony where children re -enact the story of Mary and Joseph in Bethlehem. Children dressed in costume knock on three doors seeking food and shelter. At the first two they are refused, at the third door they are welcomed in. The ritual is solemnly observed and is usually accompanied by prayers and hymns. Our fourth graders will perform this ritual for both the school and Parish at our Feast Day Celebration & Altar.

We invite you to bring your prayers and petitions to the Altar. Memorial candles, plants, pictures, and other memorabilia will be joyfully accepted to be included on the Altar. The petitions will be placed at the foot of the Altar in a basket. The basket filled with your petitions will be placed on St. Angela's Altar during mass on Suday, March 19ⁿ, the actual Feast Day of St. Joseph. Traditionally, the petitions are burned and the smoke rises to the heavens along with your prayers.
