THIRD MONTH AFTER CONCEPTION

Baby is quite active in the womb now, although the mother won't feel his or her movements for another couple months. If the mother's womb had a window, you could watch your spiritually adopted baby squint, swallow, and move his or her tongue. Vocal cords are now present, but sound can't be produced yet because of the watery environment. The baby can make a fist if you touch his or her palm, as the skin is very sensitive and reflexes are developing. It is also now distinguishable whether the baby is a boy or a girl, though it's usually a few more weeks before a doctor can determine this with an ultrasound image. The baby is breathing fluid, which will continue until birth. The needed oxygen is obtained through the umbilical cord. The baby now weighs about 1 ounce. What a miracle this baby is!







Dear Parishioners,

Happy Advent to you and your family! This first Sunday of Advent marks the beginning of the liturgical year. The Church starts us off with a game plan of preparation, so that our year may be effective and we may do great things for God at St. Angela Merici and beyond. The game plan of preparation begins with us recalling **three points in time**.



A Message from Father Beau....

The First Point: During the season of Advent, we first remember that Jesus came to us **in the womb** of Mary. We remember the anticipation of many generations that waited for the birth of the Messiah. We recall the sense of waiting – in solitude - for God Himself to come to us in the flesh.

The Second Point: Next, we become more aware of the fact that Jesus comes to us – today - in the **Eucharist**. Sometimes we fail to remember that Jesus is present now – in the flesh - and under the form of bread and wine. We say that the Eucharist is the Real Presence because Jesus Christ is truly present.

The Third Point: Finally - we remember that Jesus will come again **in glory**. What this means is that our Lord will come to us at the end of time, to judge the living and the dead. When He comes again, He will not come as an infant – and in the quiet of a manger scene. When He comes again, everyone will know it and everyone will see it. If our hearts are prepared, we should *anticipate* this day, saying the words our Lord has given us, "thy Kingdom Come", with a sense of hope.

So let us be prepared – entering into the days before His birth, preparing our lives to receive Him in the Eucharist, and preparing for His Second Coming. Let's increase our prayer life, seek to give alms to those in need, and prepare our hearts with a good Confession and penitential acts. Make this Advent count by engaging our Lord - in the season.

As always, know that your clergy and staff pray for you daily. Happy Advent!



Dear Parishioners,

Over the next two weekends before the beginning of Mass, you are going to hear from fellow parishioners about their experience of **the Alpha Course**. **What is Alpha?** Alpha is a series of sessions exploring the faith. Each session presentation looks at a different question around faith and life and is designed to create conversation. **Everyone is welcome.** What happens at Alpha?



A Message from Father Beau....

First – there's food. Our sessions start with food because it's a great way to build community and get to know each other. GREAT food. We have a new menu every night.

Then, there's the Alpha video presentation. These are *incredibly* well produced videos. They are around thirty minutes long and delivered over about 10 weeks (on Wednesday nights). Each video is design to engage and inspire conversation. They explore the big issues around faith and unpack the basics of the faith, addressing questions from *Who is Jesus?* and *How can we have faith?* to *Why and how do I pray?* and *How does God guide us? I have been through the course 3 times and I get something different out of it each time.*

This is followed by discussion at your table. Probably the most important part of any Alpha: the chance to share thoughts and ideas on the night's topic, and simply discuss it in a small group. There's no obligation to say anything and there's nothing you can't say (seriously). It's an opportunity to hear from others and contribute your own perspective in an honest, friendly and open environment.

Our first Alpha Course took place last spring, and around **60 parishioners** participated. Our 2nd Alpha began in August of this year, and **90 parishioners** went through it.

Will you join us for the Alpha Course? I know that you may have a lot of questions, and we are here to answer them. Don't hesitate to call with any questions. We will begin Alpha Course #3 on Wednesday, January 9th, 2019. **You can go to our parish website, stangela.org** and click on the Alpha link for more information and to sign up. As always, know we pray for you daily!

Dear Parishioners,

It's hard to believe that 2018 has gone by so quickly. This is our final bulletin of the year; it will cover the next two weeks – (even printing companies need a Christmas break!) But this week we are in the final week of Advent, and I want to say a few words about final preparation.

Advent is all about preparation. In our first week, we focused on the reality the Second Coming of Jesus. Now, we focus on the fact that Jesus came to us in the womb of Mary, the Mother of God and the Mother of each and every one of us.

A Message from Father Beau....

We were blessed with an outdoor nativity set this year, and placed it out in the 1st week of Advent. Each nativity set is unique – ours has Mary and St. Joseph, an empty space waiting for Baby Jesus, an angel, 3 wise men, 1 shepherd, 3 sheep, an ox, and now a

live chicken (with 3 eggs at this time of writing). Ruby, our resident hen, deposited 3 eggs in the hay, even before we set the figures in place. Providentially, she placed them directly behind St. Joseph, who stands as a protector.

Now a word about baby Jesus. Baby Jesus has been refinished, and is currently in my office, waiting to arrive. As I write, Baby Jesus is looking at me across my desk in a chair - and I was just taken off guard by God.

Having baby Jesus in my office, waiting to be placed in the manger across the street, leads me to think of God the Father, waiting for Christmas Day, when His only begotten Son would take on flesh in the womb of Mary. I have a sense of the Father's anticipation and joy.

But at the same time I think of the Father's heart, knowing that this little baby, His Son, would be rejected – almost immediately as Mary and Joseph had to flee a mad king trying to kill their child. I can't help but think of the Father's heart, knowing that His Son would one day face the Cross. I'm taken back the Father's love for the Son, and their incredible love for us.

I invite you to prayerfully consider the heart of God the Father. What can we do to respond to the coming of Jesus? There is always more to give to the One who gave us everything.


